Crimson Acres maintains a **Zero Tolerance Safety Policy**. Anyone violating safety rules outlined here or covered during the mandatory safety briefing may forfeit their shooting privileges without refund.

Release and Waiver of Liability

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Quail Shoot Safety Rules

- Hunter Orange required at all times in the field
- Eye and ear protection recommended
- No alcohol or drugs on premises or during hunts
- Treat every firearm as if it is loaded — muzzle always up or down
- Only point firearms in a safe direction; never toward another person
- Do not shoot quail that land on the ground
- Be aware of other hunters' locations — no crossing shots
- Use lite load shells with 7.5 shot as recommended
- Respect the dogs — no low shots when dogs are in the field
- Dispose of all trash and spent shells in provided receptacles
- Follow all Alabama and U.S. Federal hunting laws and regulations
