WE WILL CONTINUE TO FOLLOW OUR COVID SAFETY PROCEDURES AND PROTOCOLS DAILY BUT ALSO HAVE A PLAN IN PLACE IF A MEMBER OF OUR DANCE FAMILY CONTRACTS COVID



IF A DANCER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

The dancer can only return to dance class after at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); at least 14 days have passed since symptoms first appeared AND the student has been released by their doctor to return. We will follow CDC guidelines on disinfecting the studio in addition to routine sanitation. We will also notify all dance families of their possible exposure to COVID-19 while maintaining confidentiality as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

IF A TEACHER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

The teacher can only return to dance class at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 14 days have passed since symptoms first appeared. We will notify all dance families that took class with the teacher within a week leading up to the diagnosis. We will follow the CDC cleaning and disinfection recommendations and we will contact the local health department to follow the recommended precautions and procedures.

TRANSPARENCY

All dance families must notify the studio if their dancer has a confirmed case of COVID-19. We also expect all dance families to stay home when sick and self-quarantine if they have come in contact with someone that tested positive.
