Notice is hereby given that the Black Lake Denesuline First Nation will hold an Election on Oct. 17, 2026, in accordance with the Black Lake Denesuline First Nation Treaty 8 Benefits Trustee Election Regulations, for the purpose of electing two on-reserve candidates to the Office of Trustee, for the ensuing term of Office.

Candidates must submit their criminal record check, declaration form and two nomination forms to Chief Electoral Officer Gwen LaFond by email at ceo@uElect.ca. The declaration form, nomination forms and criminal record check must be submitted between Sept. 2 and Sept. 17, 2026, by 5:00pm CST.

Criminal Record Checks must be current to within 45 days of the Trustee Election.

Nominations will be reviewed by the Trustees and Chief Electoral Officer on Sept. 17, 2026 at 7:00pm.
