Notice is hereby given that One Arrow First Nation has called an Election in accordance with the *One Arrow First Nation Customary Election Act, 2024*, (the “Act”) for the purpose of electing one (1) Chief and eight (8) Councillors for a term of three (3) years.

PLEASE NOTE: Electors must bring acceptable Government-Issued Photo ID to present to election officials at the polls when they come to vote, such as their Status Card or Drivers’ License.

You will be required to provide your Registry Number (Status Card), Date of Birth and a personal email address (only one Elector can vote per email address). Electors must be:

- Eighteen (18) years of age or older as the date of the Election
- A registered Member of the One Arrow First Nation
- Appear on the Voters List
