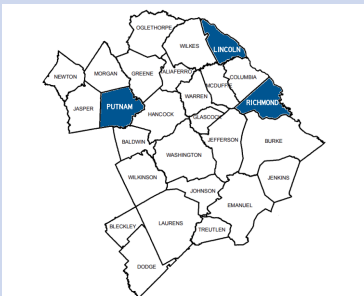

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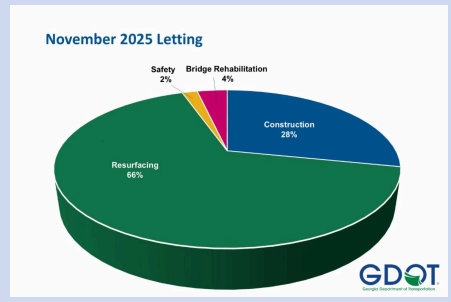
Projects awarded in east-central Georgia

The largest contract, valued at \$18.68 million, will replace a bridge in Lincoln County on SR 220 over Soap Creek, part of Clarks Hill Lake. The existing structure, built in 1952, is substandard. The new bridge will be built to modern design standards. The new structure will also be raised approximately 15 feet to provide more than 20 feet of vertical clearance over full pool, allowing for larger boat access under the new bridge.

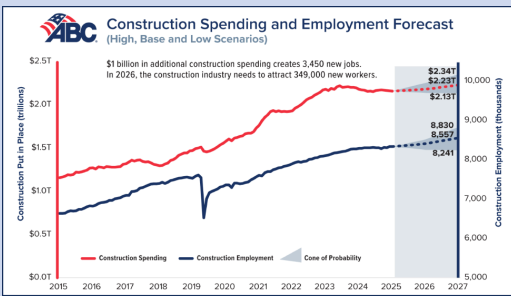
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Georgia DOT awards \$120.1 million in December

The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) awarded a total of 22 projects valued at approximately \$120.1 million at the monthly State Transportation Board meeting held in December. An additional project from November 21, 2025, was also awarded. Contracts were awarded to the lowest qualified bidders on January 2, 2026, January 7, 2026, and January 9, 2026.



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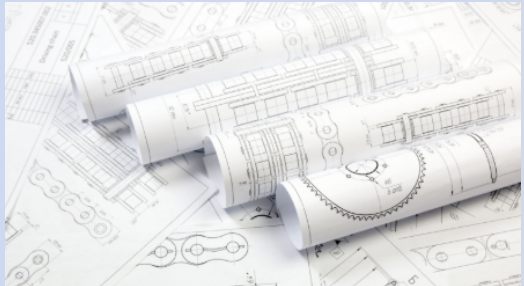
The construction industry must attract 349,000 Workers in 2026 Despite Macroeconomic Headwinds
