8th Annual GDOT/CEI Small Business Forum Highlights Opportunities for Growth and Collaboration

On November 3rd, the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), with its federally funded Supportive Services consultant, CEI hosted the 8th Annual Small Business Forum The Forum event, held in Sandy Springs,

A key highlight of the event was a panel discussion featuring Kimberly King and Julian Andrea Bailey, Diversity Manager at the Department of Administrative Services (DOAS).
