ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for the ADMSC Support Initiative, families must meet the following criteria:

1. Income Verification:

Documentation confirming the family's income is at or below the Federal Poverty Level.

- **2. Residency**: Applicants must be United State Residents.
- **3. Medical Diagnosis:** Submission of a formal diagnosis from a licensed healthcare provider outlining the condition for which ADMSC therapy is recommended.
- **4. Provider Identification:** Families are responsible for identifying a licensed and qualified provider in their area who is willing to administer the therapy.
- **5. Application Submission:** Families must complete an application to the Foundation, providing all required documentation and a detailed explanation of their circumstances.
