In May we blasted through 2000 quilts donated since we began our chapter. Officially, the total is 2010 in 49 months or 41 per month. Our total thus far in 2016 is 364, or 72.8 per month. We could hit over 800 this year at this rate. WOW!

No wonder I'm tired, I know that some of you are also. But don't give up on me yet. We are just cutting kits from the new fabric we acquired from the Jackson EMC Foundation grant. 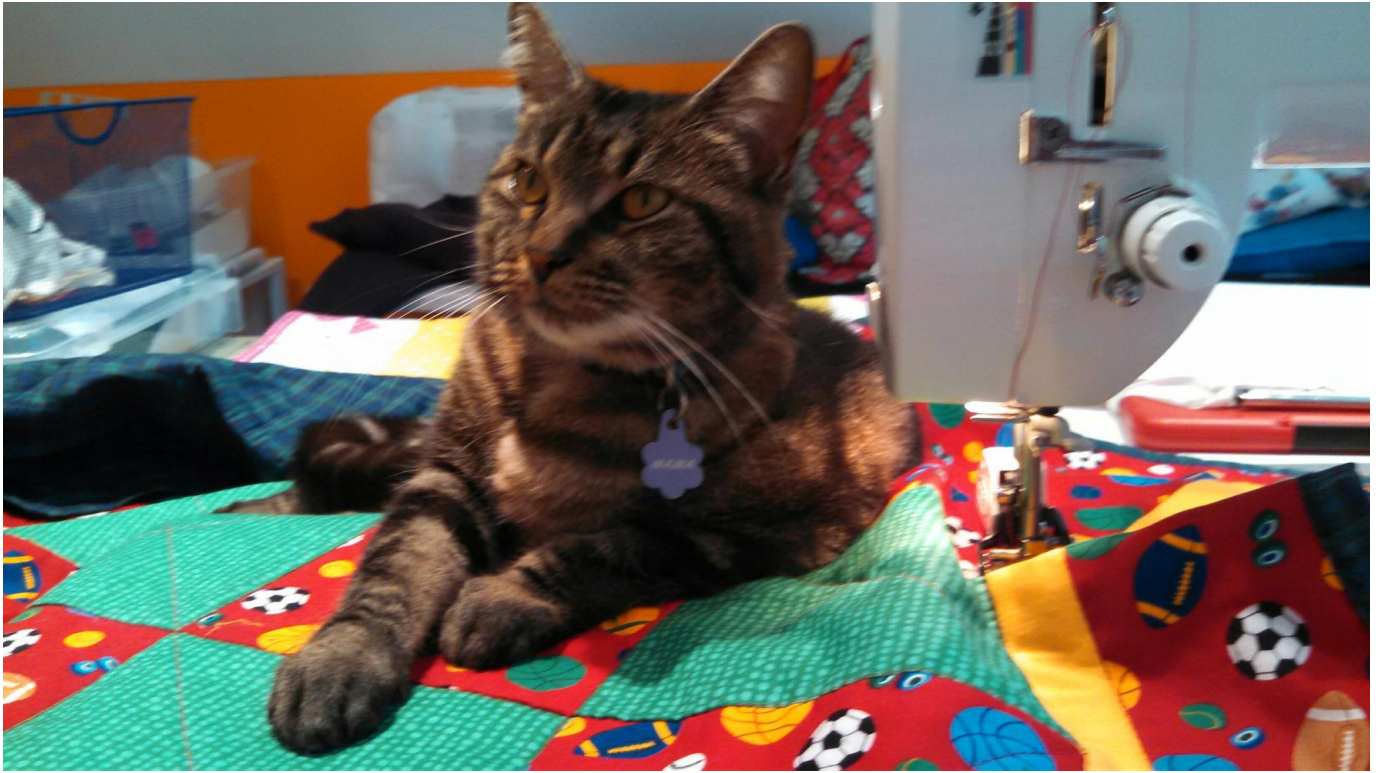
