Please know that we continue to support our three hospitals and 2 shelters by presenting the kids with our quilts. Quilts that you all make with generous love. We have now given out more than 7300 quilts and it makes my heart so grateful to know we are touching so many lives in our own little way.

Have a wonderful October and enjoy the Fall weather. The Boo Crew won't be delivering quilts on Halloween because of the new protocol but we will give the Foundation what we have to save for that week.

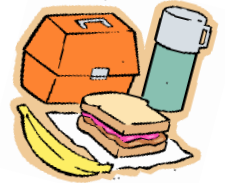
