



Provision and Use of Work Equipment (PUWER) Awareness

Our PUWER Awareness course is aimed at providing an understanding of the PUWER 1998 Regulations, to reduce the risk of harm and assist in maintaining a safe workplace.

The course would suit Supervisors, Team Leaders and Managers to assist them in understanding the principles of control and provide information on points to consider to reduce the likelihood and severity of harm in the workplace for a variety of work equipment.

Course Content:

The course will cover the following learning outcomes:

- Legislation: Health & Safety at Work Act 1974, The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999, The Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998
- Overview of work equipment and general requirements
- Main hazards of work equipment – machinery, appliance, apparatus & tools - including mechanical and non-mechanical injuries
- Principles of Hierarchy of Control
- Overview on managing risks from use of work equipment
