



Behavioural Safety

Our Behavioural Safety course is aimed at providing an awareness of the importance of individual behaviour and the impact this can have on workplace safety. Accidents and incidents are undesired events and behind these events are Unsafe Acts and Unsafe Conditions. The Unsafe Acts of individuals are believed to account for in excess of 80% of all workplace incidents and accidents. This course is a must if we are to address this issue.

Course Content:

The course will cover the following learning outcomes:

- Management of Health & Safety
- Why people behave unsafely
- Behavioural Safety – Organisation, Job & Individual Factors
- The 6 Pillars of Behavioural Safety – Leadership, Engagement, Coaching, Communication, Recognition and Measurement
- Safety Culture & Behaviour Modification
- Implementation & Intervention
