



Risk Assessment

Our Risk Assessment course is aimed at providing an understanding of the 5 steps of a risk assessment. Learners will be taught how to follow these steps and apply the hierarchy of control in the workplace to assist in creating a safer working environment. Learners will complete a risk assessment exercise during the course to ensure they have understood the key stages and can apply the hierarchy of control.

The course would suit all levels of employees to improve their understanding of the importance of workplace risk assessments, compliance with the controls that are within and in being able to assess a risk in their workplace.

Course Content:

The course will cover the following learning outcomes:

- Legislation: Health & Safety at Work Act 1974, The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999
- Key H&S terminology – Hazard, Risk, Likelihood and Consequence
- The 5 steps to a risk assessment
 - Identify the hazard
 - Identify who could be harmed and how
 - Evaluate the risk and identify controls
 - Record the findings
 - Review the findings
- The hierarchy of control
- Conduct a risk assessment
