



DSE & Workstation Assessment

Our DSE & Workstation Assessment course is aimed at providing an overview of the requirements of workplace assessment for those working with DSE or at Work Stations for prolonged periods. The course will cover the legislation, the effects to individuals health and measures to be taken to manage the risk in the workplace.

This course is aimed at Supervisors and Managers to assist in their risk assessment, identifying corrective actions required to manage the risk of working with DSE and Workstations in the workplace.

Course Content:

The course will cover the following learning outcomes:

- Overview of legislation: Health & Safety at Work Act 1974, The Health and Safety (Display Screen Equipment) Regulations 1992, Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER)
- Hazards of a Workstation – including WRULDs, Eye Strain, DVT etc.
- Workplace Ergonomics – the impact of poor design
- Principles of Prevention
- DSE Assessment
- Workplace Observations & Assessment
