

A man was hired to paint a boat. He gathered his paint and brushes and painted the boat bright red, just as the owner had asked. While working, he noticed a small hole in the hull and quietly repaired it without saying a word.

After finishing the paint job, he was paid for his work and went on his way.

The next day, the boat owner returned to the painter with a generous check, much more than the original payment. The painter was surprised and said, "You've already paid me for painting the boat, sir!"

The owner smiled and replied, "This isn't for the paint job—it's for fixing the hole in the boat."

The painter, puzzled, said, "But it was such a small thing... surely it wasn't worth this much."

The owner's face grew serious. "You don't understand. Let me explain: When I asked you to paint the boat, I forgot to mention the hole. Yesterday, after the paint dried, my children took the boat out for a fishing trip without knowing about the hole, and I wasn't home at the time. When I realized what had happened, I was filled with dread. I was sure something terrible would happen. But when I saw them return safely, my heart was filled with relief. I inspected the boat and realized you had repaired the hole."

"You see, my friend, you saved the lives of my children. I can never repay you enough for that small act of kindness."

The story reminds us that no matter who we are, how small the act may seem, or when we offer help, we can make a profound difference in someone's life. You never know when your actions might repair a "hole" for someone else, and in doing so, save their life.

Do everything as for Jesus - you just might save someone's life!




