Bible

Clothing: Clothing that is modest and in keeping with Christian standards. No short shorts or halter tops, or tops with spaghetti straps. If you can't wear it to school, please don't wear it to camp. Swimsuits should be one piece and not French cut. Those with two piece or French cut swimsuits will be expected to wear a T-shirt at the pool. Bring appropriate clothing, like a jacket or sweatshirt, pants, in case of cool nights.

Please bring *at least one pair* of shoes that you can run in.

Personal Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, wash cloths, towels, shampoo, etc. Hand sanitizer will be provided, but you can bring your own if you like.

Bedding: Either a sleeping bag or sheets, blankets, and pillow.

Optional: notebook, pen or pencil, camera, fan, insecticide, flashlight, clothes hangers.

We highly suggest all campers bring their own **water bottle** (marked with the camper's name).

What Not to Bring...

Electronic devices (Cell phones, ipad, ipod, games, etc.), fireworks, any type of weapon, tobacco, money.
