She was a little lady with a big heart and a huge request. She was only 4 foot 3 inches tall. Her mission vision was to share the gospel with the people of China, 472 million at the time. That was in 1887. Her impassioned request was for believers back home in America to take up an offering at Christmas to send missionaries to China. \$3,315 was given.

Since then, over 5 billion dollars have been given! More importantly, 176,795 new believers came to faith in Christ among our missionaries last year.

I've heard about Lottie all my life. She was an amazing person. She died on Christmas Eve, 1912 weighing only 50 pounds. She'd been using her money to buy food for people in China. Starvation helped to end her life.

In a letter to America, she wrote, "Why should we not ... do something that will prove that we are really in earnest in claiming to be followers of him who, though he was rich, for our sake became poor?" (Sept. 15, 1887, Tungchow) When she wrote these words, she had in mind the portion of scripture that says, "... prove...your love also is genuine. For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake, he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich." (2 Corinthians 8:8-9 ESV) This chapter in the New Testament is all about growing in giving.

So today we have to ask ourselves are we that passionate about sharing Jesus? We have been given much, and we need to share what we have to help others around the world come to know Jesus as Savior!

As I compose this information for the newsletter, we are just one month away from collection week for Operation Christmas Child. I hope you all are busy making final purchases and packing your boxes. I want to extend another invitation to drop by and work a shift during collection week at First Baptist Church in Belle. We are open to receive boxes Monday, November 14, 9 - 11am and 3-7 pm, Tuesday, November 15, 9-11am, Wednesday, November 16, 9-11am, Thursday, November 17, 9-11am and 6-8pm, Friday, November 18, 9-11am, Saturday, November 19, 9-11am, Sunday, November 20, 1-3pm and for anyone that still has boxes, Monday, November 21, 8-11am. This year's dedication service will be Sunday November 20 at 2pm. We will not be passing boxes this year but I would invite each of you that are coming that day to hang on to one of your boxes and during the service we will have a time for each of you to place it in a carton and pray. We will also have a time of fellowship after the service.

I want to remind everyone that cartons of 50 boxes are available for purchase for \$33 from the Samaritan's Purse website.

Last year we collected 1976 boxes at Belle. This year I've been praying that God would bless us with 2000 or more.


