I am taking another trip and would love to take a team with me in the spring 2024. If you are interested in more information whether it be in traveling with me, donations or just prayers please contact me.




Pray and Serve The VOICC of Martyrs January 2-6, 2024, we will travel to Bartlesville,

#### **Dealing with drought**

sent to us by Duane Berry, Worship Pastor at FBC Owensville. Have you ever lived through a drought? If so, you know the progression: not only do the plants begin to wither from lack of rain, but the sun beats hotter, the ground cracks open, the birds and the animals begin to abandon the area, and people become very discouraged. Those who are most dependent on the water supply become desperate, even frantic, as their investments, their livelihood, and then their survival is threatened. The same is true when there is a spiritual drought. When a community of believers forgets its life source, there is a progression of the death of spirit. First, the seeds that have been planted die; there are few new believers. The hardships of life begin to get harder to endure, the foundation upon which the community stands begins to crack. Those who need the Spirit to sustain them go elsewhere, those who remain become discouraged until the survival of the community is in danger. That's why we must continually pray for the Holy Spirit to be poured down upon us. He is our life source. Without Him, our plans and our programs will crumble like the dusty ground. We must bathe our lives in the Spirit – as individuals and as a community of believers. And it is the worshipers who must step out to lead the prayer, "Holy Spirit, Come." Come and pour out your Spirit upon our church. Nothing delights God more than to soak us, to pour out His Spirit. If you want your church, your Bible Study group, your choir to grow, nothing is more effective than praying for God to come and pour out His Spirit.
