### **GOVERNMENT GIVES GO AHEAD TO SIKH SCHOOL PROPOSAL**

**Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2004**

The Schools Adjudicator has today given his approval for the proposed Sikh Faith Primary school in Slough. This has over turned the decision made by Slough's Schools Organisation Committee in November 2003. The Slough Sikh School Trust has been campaigning for support from all groups to support its cause.

The Trust on behalf of the 10,000 Sikhs in Slough was seeking the same basic rights for Sikh parents that other majority faiths have, the right to send their children to a faith school. Currently Sikhs and other minorities have a choice of sending their children to a Christian school or a non-denominational school but not a school of their own faith.

The adjudicator summarised his decision as follows:

*“ There is such clear evidence of parental demand from parents and the community for a Sikh school points to the probability that such a school would be more popular with Sikh parents than the existing schools and that the school would have enough support to achieve reasonable educational standards. I have concluded that this is enough to justify the case for approval on parental preference, community demand and standards grounds. ”*

This decision demonstrates that the Government is supporting the needs of minorities in Education. Even though the Trust has faced many hurdles over the last four years, we are delighted that we have had this decision.

The delays that we have now experienced means that this has delayed the start of the Sikh school in Slough until Sept 2006 (assuming planning permission is granted)





## THE LAMBOURNE CLUB

The Lambourne Club is set in 180 acres of breathtaking parkland with magnificent old oak and beech trees and 6 picturesque lakes. It is one of the most prestigious private clubs in the region. ## Slough Sikh School Project

We have the pleasure of announcing the launch of a £7,000,000 school project in Slough, now in its final stages. The project started through identification of a gap in the current schooling services and as a result we proposed a self sustaining strategy to cover the needs of Slough's growing population. The Government has demonstrated its support for the school with a £6.2M grant. The primary school is Voluntarily Aided and will cater for 450 children aged 4 to 11.

The school will allow us to formally provide a rich and comfortable learning environment for our children. Our dream is to create a school which will generate children who are proud of their identity and have the highest social and moral values.

The school will follow the National Curriculum, and will be managed and run by a governing body that will consist of teachers, parents, trustees and the LEA. 20% of school places have been reserved for children from other faiths so that we can cater for the larger community. There will be additional lessons in Sikh Studies, Music and the Punjabi language.

The teachers will be from different faiths and it will be a modern school with new ideas, with the latest technology and with lots of after school activities such as Adult Education, Adult Support Groups, Youth Support Groups and Sports Activities

With a target of £800,000 to raise, we are venturing into various fund raising activities, one of which is a series of Charity Golf Tournaments.


