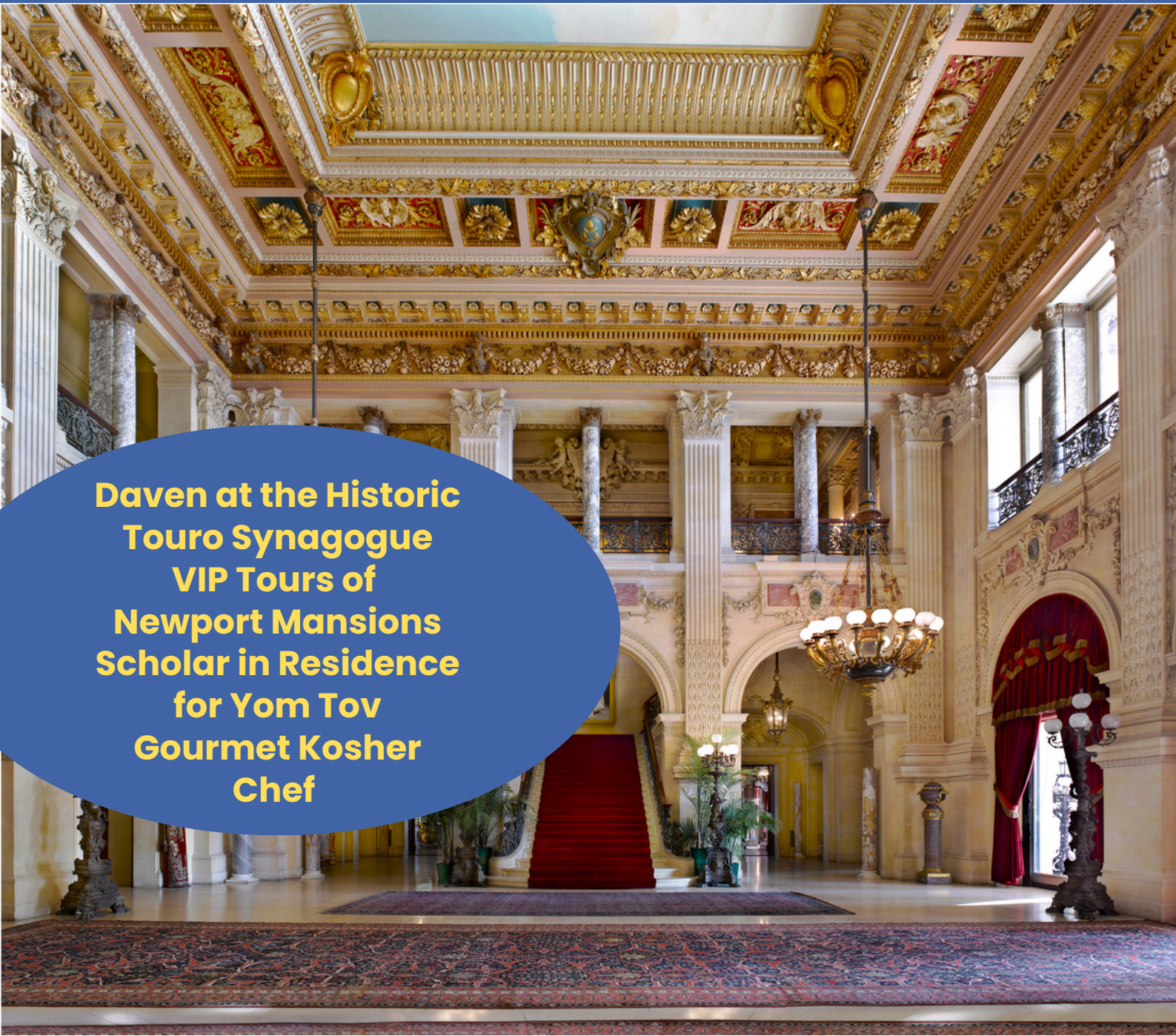

MONDAY, OCTOBER 2

NEWPORT

Begin your tour at **The Breakers** Mansion, the grandest of all the Newport summer homes, built by **Cornelius Vanderbilt II** in 1895. The mansion boasts 70 rooms, including a marble staircase, ornate ballroom, and opulent dining room. From there, we'll visit the **Marble House**, a stunning mansion built by William Vanderbilt for his wife Alva in 1892. You'll be transported back to the Gilded Age with the mansion's grand reception room, elaborate gold ballroom, and **Chinese tea house**. We will end our day at the Historic **Touro Synagogue**.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 3

NEWPORT

Today we bevisiting four mansions: **Chateau-sur-Mer**, a Victorian-era mansion built in 1852, and learn about the house's history and architecture, **Rough Point**, the summer home of heiress Doris Duke, built in 1891. You'll marvel at the mansion's stunning ocean views and impressive art collection, **The Elms**, a French-style chateau built in 1901, and **Rosecliff**, an elegant mansion that hosted the Newport Jazz Festival.

Daytime temperatures range from cool to mild, usually in the mid 60s F with cooler evenings, and rain is always a possibility. Participants should be fit and in active good health. As of publication, all participants and tour staff will be required to be fully vaccinated for SARS-COV-2 (COVID-19), plus follow safety/sanitization protocols set forth by the tour operator, local staff, and host country laws. By forwarding the deposit for passage, the participant certifies that they do not have any physical or other limitation that would create a hazard for themselves or other travelers.

MrsVanderbilt.com's group sizes are limited to a maximum of 48 participants, ensuring that you have a personalized and enriching experience.
