Mr. Wallin is also the Head Girls' Golf Coach at Rosemount High School. Coach Wallin is assisted by accomplished collegiate and high school golfers who are also excellent at working with kids.

Emerald Greens Junior Golf Lessons

Levels include Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced, and Parent/Child for youth ages 5 through 14. All equipment is provided (for those who want it).

Weekly Golf Lessons for Beginners/Intermediates:

Six (6) once a week 1.75 hour lessons beginning the week of June 15 and ending during the week of July 27, skipping lessons the week of 6/29 – 7/3). Students will be grouped within each session according to age/ability and friends. The week of August 3 will be used as a make-up week for rainouts. Intermediate golfers will also play each week in the 8 AM Thursday morning league.

Choose Beginner or Intermediate:

Beginner Topics: Full swing, putting, chipping, pitching, safety, and etiquette.

Fee: \$165, includes six 1.75 hour lessons, use of all equipment, a golf t-shirt, & bag tag.

Intermediate Topics: Full swing, putting, chipping, pitching, sand play, course strategy, safety, terminology, and etiquette.

Fee: \$265, includes six 1.75 hour lessons, 6 nine-hole league greens fees, a golf t-shirt, and a bag tag.

One Week Golf Camp for Beginners/Intermediates:

Four (4) daily lessons running Monday through Thursday of the same week. Each day's lesson lasts 1.75 hours. Students will be grouped in each session according to age/ability and friends. Recommended ages 5 to 14.

Fee: \$109, includes four 1.75 hour lessons, use of all equipment, a golf t-shirt, and bag tag. Topics include full swing, putting, chipping, pitching, safety, and etiquette.

Beginners Camps: Offered June 15–18, June 22–25, July 6–9, July 13–16, July 20–23, or July 27–30. Fridays will be used each week as a rainout make-up day.

Choose a time: 10:00 AM to 11:45 AM
12:00 PM to 1:45 PM
2:30 PM to 4:15 PM
4:30 PM to 6:15 PM
7:00 PM to 8:45 PM (only available the weeks of June 15–18 and June 22–25).

Intermediate and Advanced Summer Golf Academy:

Six once a week 3-hour lessons from the week of June 15 through the week of July 27, skipping the week of June 29 – July 3. These lessons are open to all experienced junior golfers, but are designed with the avid golfer in mind. The week of August 4 will be used as a make-up week for rainouts. In addition to the topics listed, students will also play golf with one of our staff during each lesson on one of our regulation courses. Recommended ages 6 to 14. Max of 6 students per session.

Choose the time/day: 12:30 PM to 3:30 PM (Mo, Tu, or We)
5:00 PM to 8:00 PM (Mo, Tu, or We)
8:00 AM to 11:00 AM (Th only)

Topics: Full swing I, II, III, IV, and V, putting, chipping, pitching, sand play, shot trajectory, safety, terminology, etiquette, course management, and the Rules of Golf.

Fee: \$349, includes six once a week 3-hour lessons, video analysis of full swing, an embroidered Titleist hat, use of all equipment, a golf t-shirt, a bag tag, and playing privileges during each lesson.

Parent/Child Golf Lessons:

These four 1-hour lessons and the 3-hour on-course lesson (OCL) are designed to provide a solid introduction to the game of golf for a junior golfer (recommended ages 5 to 14) and one parent. Emphasis will be on helping each golfer feel comfortable & competent on the golf course. Topics include putting, chipping, full swing, and etiquette.

Session 1:

Saturdays (May 9, 16, 30 and June 6) at 1:30 PM or 2:30 PM. Rainout make-up if needed: June 13.

A 3-hour "on-the-course" lesson is also included in these lessons: June 20, 22, 23, or 24 at 6 PM. There is NO extra fee for the OCL.

Session 2:

Mondays (July 6, 13, 20, and 27) at 6:15 PM or 7:15 PM.
Tuesdays (July 7, 14, 21, and 28) at 6:15 PM or 7:15 PM.
Wednesdays (July 8, 15, 22, and 29) at 6:15 PM or 7:15 PM.
Thursdays (July 9, 16, 23, and 30) at 6:15 PM or 7:15 PM.
Saturdays (July 11, 18, 25, and Aug 1) at 1:30 PM or 2:30 PM.

The week of August 4 will be used as a make-up week for rainouts. A 3-hour "on-the-course" lesson is also included on August 10, 11, 12, or 15 at 5 PM. There is NO extra fee for the OCL.

Fee: \$80 per parent/child pair (\$40 each additional parent or child) which includes four 1-hour lessons, a 3-hour on-course lesson, use of all equipment, a youth t-shirt, and a bag tag.
