Greetings members,

We are excited to announce that we are in the beginning stages of developing Women's Groups

in your community! These Groups will consist of consistent meetings as agreed (minimum once

a month) by Group members and will be funded through Indigenous Women of Wabanaki

Territories on agreeance of a four-year term.

Our goal with these groups is to disrupt systematic exclusion of Wabanaki women at provincial

policy and consultation tables through organization and training to teach advocation for the

rights of its peoples to have their voices included in provincial levels. Meeting at least every

month to reflect and provide guidance on current issues affecting Wabanaki women. Planning

strategic ideas to create an environment conducive to healing the land, women, generations

ahead and work together to voice public awareness on the identified issues. Women's Groups

will have the opportunity to learn from one another to strengthen Wabanaki women's leadership

and contribute to their traditional teachings to create awareness of the traditional governance. We

want to get back to our traditional ways, our culture and come together as a community to bring

back our ceremonies, crafts, food sovereignty and strengthen our connection to our land, people

and revitalize our languages. We also want to provide mentorship opportunities from our

matriarchs to our youth.
