Bible Insight:

What Does the Immaculate Conception Mean?


The Immaculate Conception means that Mary was conceived without sin. From the first moment of her existence, she was preserved from original sin and remained pure throughout her life. Although Mary faced temptation like any human being, she remained faithful and chose good through God's grace. In the Gospel of Luke, Mary is called Kecharitomene, meaning "full of grace" or "highly favored." God granted her this unique grace because His sinless Son, Jesus, would take His human nature from a sinless mother. Some Christians argue that if Mary was sinless, she did not need a Savior. However, Scripture and the Church teach that she did need a Savior (Luke 1:47). She was saved not from past sin, but preventatively, by being preserved from sin through Christ's merits. **Related Scripture:** Luke 1:28, 47; John 1:14; Romans 3:10–12; Hebrews 4:14–15; Genesis 3:15; Jeremiah 1:5 **Catechism:** CCC 273, 411, 485–495

¿Qué significa la Inmaculada Concepción?

La Inmaculada Concepción enseña que María fue concebida sin pecado original y permaneció sin pecado toda su vida por gracia de Dios. Fue preservada del pecado para ser la madre sin mancha de Jesús. Aunque fue sin pecado, sí necesitó un Salvador: Cristo la salvó de manera preventiva, preservándola del pecado desde el inicio.


