John 14:6 - Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Bible Insight: WHY DOES THE CHURCH NOT ORDAIN WOMEN?

The Church always recognizes the blessings and treasures that she receives from women. The Church follows the example of Jesus, who chose men for the ministry of the priesthood: “Then Jesus went up a hill and called to himself the men he wanted. They came to him, and he chose twelve” (Mark 3:13–14). But there are many other ministries in the Church that are led by women, and this is wonderful. It is a blessing.

The Old Testament mentions by name four “prophetesses”: Miriam, the sister of Aaron (Exodus 15:20); Deborah in the time of the Judges (Judges 4:4); Huldah, during the reign of Josiah (2 Kings 22:14); and Noadiah, in the time of Nehemiah (Nehemiah 6:14). Also, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel (Luke 2:36), could be included. In the New Testament, we see women accompanying Jesus (Luke 8:2–3; Mk. 15:40–41).

Mary, the mother of Jesus, was the first and best disciple of Jesus (Mark 3:31–35); Mary Magdalene was the first witness of the Resurrection (Mark 16:9). So, women have had a special place in the plan of salvation. Saint Paul gave special recognition to a woman named Phoebe; this is why some scholars think that she may have been a kind of deaconess (Romans 16:1–2), but it is not clear.
