



Bible Insight:

CAN THE POPE MAKE WRONG DECISIONS?

As human beings we have been limited by our sins. As human beings, we are always learning. So, in this sense, even the Pope as a human being, he is limited and he could make wrong decisions. However, when He is talking in "Ex-cathedra" He is out of error. "Ex-cathedra" means giving statements and declarations consulted with different experts and councils, in union with the bishops and under prayers, after a lot of meditation.

Catechesis of the Catholic Church number 891 says: Ex-cathedra term describing the most solemn and authoritative infallible statements of the church. The first Vatican Council (1869-1870) declared that the Pope may teach infallibly when He speaks: (1) as Solemn Pastor, (2) in virtue of his apostolic authority as Saint Peter's successor (3) in matters of faith and morals, (4) so as to bind the universal church.

This declaration of "Ex-cathedra" is based on the power and authority that Jesus gave to his disciples: "Then Jesus approached to the eleven and said: "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them...(Mt. 28:18-20).
