Bible Insight: WHY DO WE KEEP JESUS ON THE CROSS IF HE IS RESURRECTED?

For the Jewish people, a cross alone does not mean anything, because historically in Jerusalem and other places, the cross was a common instrument of torment and death. Many condemned people were killed on crosses.

So, from the beginning, to make a distinction, the Catholic Church showed the Jewish people the meaning of keeping the cross of Jesus. Jesus was unjustly killed on one of them. After the Resurrection, the cross came to mean salvation—the way to attain salvation. Saint Paul says: “But may I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world” (Galatians 6:14; also Col. 2:14; Ephesians 2:16; Philippians 3:18; 1 Cor. 1:23).

There are many crosses, but only one is the Cross of Christ; only the Cross of Christ saves us. This is why the Church continues to keep Jesus on the cross as a sign that this is the Cross of Christ.

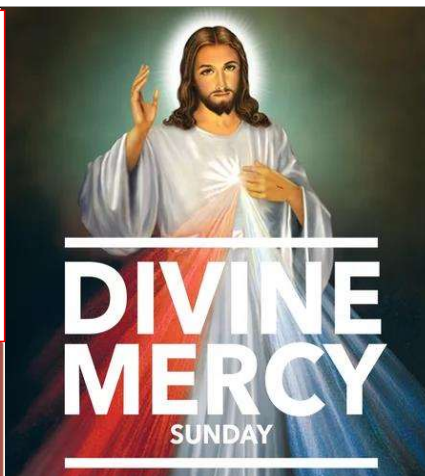
