HOW TO KNOW THAT IT IS THE HOLY SPIRIT WORKING?

The church knows and has taught that the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Most Holy Trinity. This is why the Holy Spirit cannot be manipulated.

There are lots of confusions and misunderstanding about how and through who the Holy Spirit works. The Holy Spirit is the promise the Jesus made to his apostles, and also is only through the disciples and successors who the Holy Spirit will work (Mt. 28:16-20; Acts 2:4; Acts 1:8; John 20:22-23). According to what we read in the Acts of the Apostles book the Holy Spirit is present when the disciples or their successors prayed or invoked his presence: "Peter said: As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them as it had upon us at the beginning," (Acts 11:15).

We can find many times in which the Holy Spirit appeared when the apostles and their successors invoked him; even the Holy Spirit talked to the disciples: "While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting; the Holy Spirit said: Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul," (Acts 13:2). Actually, the Holy Spirit comes upon people when the ordained ministers invoke him during administrating the sacraments, especially baptism, confirmation and Holy Orders.

Other experiences related with the presence of the Holy Spirit like on retreats or healing masses, it is the awaking of the Holy Spirit that already lives in us since we were baptized. We know that God goes beyond the church and its ministers but according to what we can see in the bible, the Holy Spirit normally come through the ordained ministers.
