BIBLE INSIGHT: WHAT IS A LITURGICAL YEAR?
It is the year of the church. It starts the first advent Sunday thru the solemnity of Christ the King. The church runs on a yearly calendar sanctifying the times and seasons. This calendar has different cycles varying importance. The church year spans of four special seasons: Advent/Christmas, Lent, Easter and Ordinary time (this season is divided in two moments during the year).
The liturgical color of the vestments and the altar cloth reveal the season. For example: Advent is symbolized in purple- the purple color means “expectation” and “preparation.” Advent is always the beginning and the end of the liturgical year. Christmas is symbolized in white- white color means “purity,” light” and “peace.” Christmas in the church is not just one day, we celebrate Christmas for almost 3 weeks. For Lent, the color change back to purple that means expectation with sacrifice. Easter uses the white color like Christmas. Finally, ordinary time uses the green color that means growth, maturity, and work. We use Ordinary time to work on our spiritual life. The church focuses on the teachings of ministry of Jesus. Bible quotation is Ecclesiastes 3:1-8.

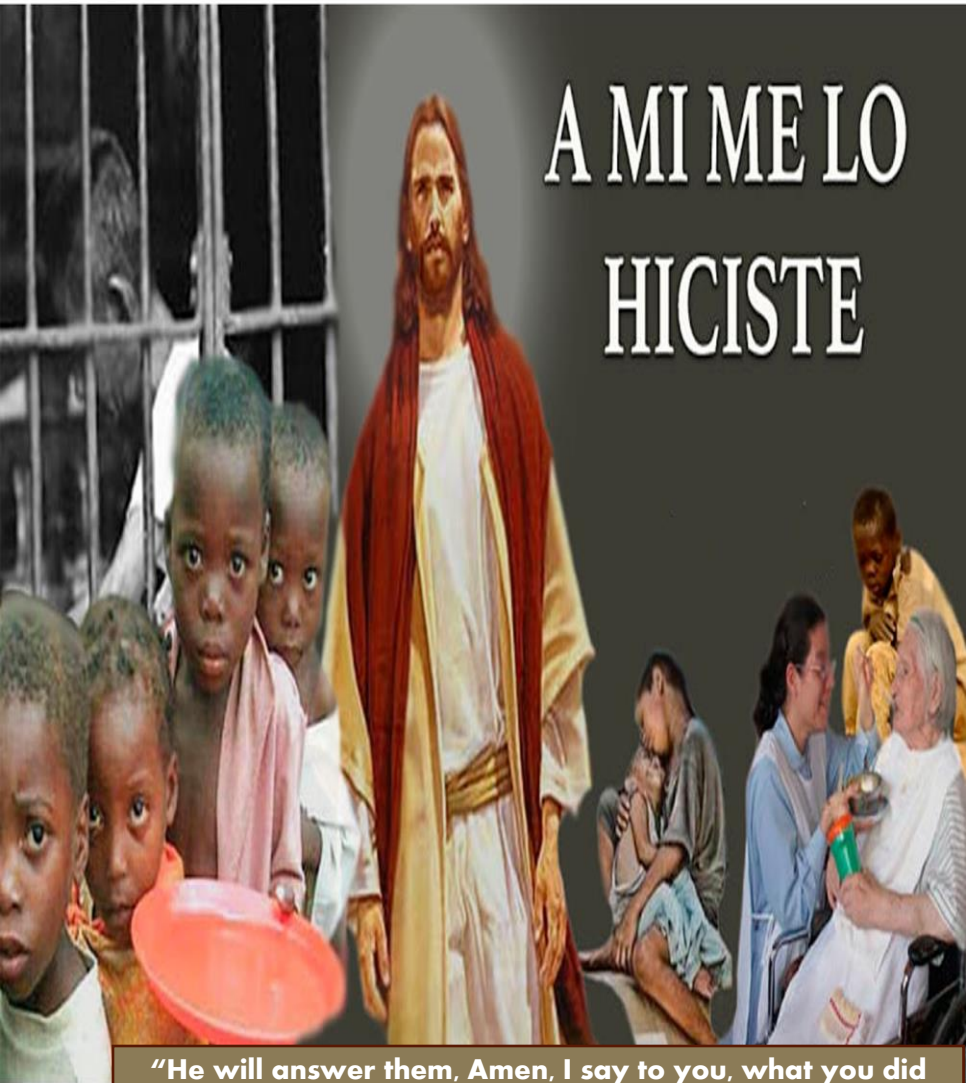
