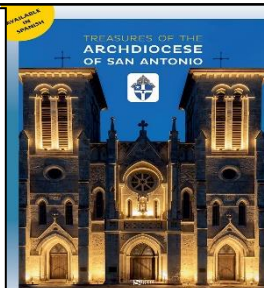

BIBLE INSIGHT: WHAT WAS THE APPEARANCE OF JESUS?

(second part) The disciples of Jesus and the first believers did not think about pictures or paintings of Jesus because they saw him; this is why it was not important. In the book of revelation 1:12-16, there is a vision the author had “someone like a son of man.” Based on Isaiah 53:2 some Fathers of the church like Justin (d. 165) and Tertullian (d. 220) believed that Christ’s appearance was unremarkable. The most important reflection is our love for him. The different images of Jesus and his face are our real treasure of evangelization of the church. These images helped the church communicate the message to the people from the different cultures, languages and ages. The church never lied to the people. Nowadays, we continue to find the face of Jesus in the people who suffer. They asked to Jesus: “When did we ever see you sick or in prison and visit you” the king will reply: “I tell you when you did this for one of the least important of these followers of mine, you did it to me,” (Matthew 25:31-46). Jesus said to Thomas: “Do you believe because you see me, how happy are those who believe without seeing me,” (John 20:29).
