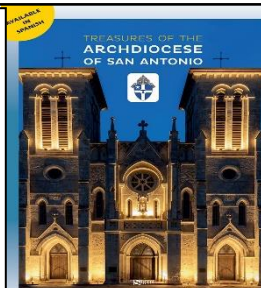

BIBLE INSIGHT:

DID JESUS PARTICIPATE IN POLITICAL MATTERS?

The mission of Jesus was to “proclaim that the kingdom of God was at hand” (Mark 1:15) and He said that his kingdom was not from here (Saint John 18:36-37). However, the call to feed the hungry, clothe the naked, care for the sick and the afflicted, comfort the victims of injustice (Matthew 25: 34-46). This requires more than an individual act of charity (Catholicism p. 717). As a good teacher, Jesus advised us on how to relate with governors and the people in power. He recommended to pay taxes (Mt. 18:27-34; Mark 2:27). He recognized that some governors overlord the people (Mt. 20:25-28). Jesus called Herod “fox” and John the Baptist reprimanded Herod (Luke 3:18-19).

The church’s involvement in the social and political order is justified based on social and institutional characters of sin itself. When we say “church” we primarily invite the lay people to participate in the inclusion of the message of God in all the levels of our society. The church intervention in the social and political order must always be responsible, never arbitrary, particularly in the light of the church’s limited resource (Catholicism p. 729).
