

Scoring information

This will be a round robin tournament. Games are first to 21 points.

Each team plays all other teams once. After round robin play, teams are seeded according to their records and point differentials. The top teams advance to a single-elimination bracket.

- Gameplay: Players alternate by tossing their bags toward the opposite board. A bag through the hole scores 3 points, a bag landing on the board scores 1 point, and a bag that lands on the ground or bounces in scores 0 points. Points are tallied for each team after all 8 bags are thrown.
- 2. Scoring: Cancellation scoring is used, where only the higher-scoring team scores any points.
- Team 1 scores 4 pts and team 2 scores 2 pts
 Team 1 scoring 2 pts
- The last team to score points at the end of each turn goes first for the next turn.
