The game began to swing the way of the visitors as Ewhare came close once again from another counterattack. The winger skipped away from 3 defenders until the ball rolled out of his path as he prepared to pull the trigger. Christian North was out quick to block the poked effort.

With time running out Ewhare got another sight at goal but was denied this time by the foot of North who made a fantastic save.

But there was nothing to separate the two sides inside 90 minutes and the game went to a penalty shootout.

After 2 penalties scored for both teams, Siemienczuk converted and Metalia hit the post for Tilbury which meant advantage North Greenford. Which they made full use of, scoring all 5 penalties to advance to the FA Vase Sixth Round 5-3 on penalties.
