The Dockers soon doubled their lead as Spooner's long throw troubled the Pitsea Athletic defence once again. Phillips was the target, and his flick on found Akintunde, who reacted first and poked home from close range.

The second half squad would extend this lead with 15 minutes to go, as a beautiful run down the left-hand side from the full-back orchestrated the opportunity for a pass across the box, and a tidy finish from the midfielder.

And almost directly from kick-off, the game was put to bed when the left-back was involved again. His perfect delivery found the opposite full-back, and a lovely, powerful header into the top corner was the story for Tilbury's fourth.
