Solicitor's Report for December 2025 Board Meeting:

1. Solicitor, Edward M. Brennan presented to the Board continuing to do the liens for tax sales, real estate sales and mortgage foreclosures and satisfaction for liens and that means we are getting paid. Brenda Schuettler is a big help. We have to keep track of the liens on record and also Sheriff Sales getting the updated amounts for the liens.

2. Solicitor, Edward M. Brennan presented to the Board on Division Street we are still working on that and East Mahantongo Street, waiting to hear back from the City of Pottsville on the subdivision which should be approved at the January Council Meeting.

3. Solicitor, Edward M. Brennan presented to the Board the delinquent properties owned by Neinhart a judgement was recorded, and a lien is on the property and a lien on the company also.

3. Solicitor, Edward M. Brennan presented to the Board personnel issues were discussed with Mr. Orlowsky and Mr. Minnig and resolved.

CONSULTING ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Keith Heigel presented his report in written form. Refer to the attached report from Light- Heigel & Associates, Inc. for December 2025.

1. Mr. Heigel presented for the Board's information we are continuing to work with Mr. Orlowsky on the Division Street Project, the PennDot permit is pending. PennDot asked for an additional dimension to be placed on their application. PennDot did not exempt our fee. The permit will be issued after the holidays.

Light-Heigel & Associates request Mr. Aungst to provide Bonding, and DEP is reviewing the permit for this project.

3. Mr. Heigel presented for the Board's information on the Arch Collapse and the removal of the restroom.

Discussion followed.

4. Mr. Heigel presented for the Board's information we are working on the permit for the Water Quality Application which will include the 18" sewer line starting on Second and going to Prospect Street.

5. Mr. Heigel presented for the Board's information he has been working with Mr. Orlowsky on the Act 537 Plan and where we are putting the pump station and we may need an easement.

6. Mr. Heigel present for the Board's information on the manhole issue in Port Carbon, the coffer dam was going to come down as long as price is lower than \$20,000.00.

Mr. Orlowsky stated he spoke with the Fabcor contractor and the issue is the soft soil in that area is not suited for this structure also the backhoe cannot get to the bottom of the manhole because it is below the creek.

Discussion followed.

Ronald C. Zimmerman stated he spoke to Mr. Tohill, Port Carbon Engineer and Mr. Tohill said the contractor would have to put up a barrier wall to do the excavating which is dangerous.

7. Mr. Heigel presented for the Board's information on the underground scans Norwegian Creek are completed and next year will scan the surface.

8. Mr. Heigel presented for the Board's information met with the structural engineer and the operator for the catwalk.
