

MY HOME PODIATRIST PRIVACY POLICY

Our Commitment to your Privacy

My Home Podiatrist respects your rights to privacy and confidentiality and is committed to complying with the *Privacy Act 1988* and the *Australian Privacy Principles 2014* and any privacy provisions of applicable legislation. My Home Podiatrist is an independent practice.

My Home Podiatrist Privacy Policy sets out our commitment to protecting the privacy of your personal information that we collect directly from you or from the website www.myhomepodiatrist.net.au. It covers all personal information we hold, that is, information, or an opinion about an individual, whose identity is apparent, or can be reasonably ascertained, from that information or opinion.

Collection of Personal Information

The type of personal information that we collect may include:

- Name.
- Contact details including email address, residential address and telephone numbers,
- Date of birth,
- Gender.
- Occupation,
- Employer details if applicable (WorkCover claims etc),
- Sensitive information including health and medical information, Medicare or DVA details (if applicable), your General Practitioner, the Referring doctor or person (if applicable) and other necessary health information,
- Any other information requested by us or provided by you.

If we receive personal information from third parties, eg other health professionals, we will protect it as set out in this Privacy Policy.

Use of Personal Information

In order to provide a quality service to you, we need to collect personal and sensitive information. We will only collect information from you which is necessary. however, should you choose not to provide the necessary information, it may affect your treatment and/or we may be unable to treat you.

We collect information for the purposes which may include:

- To assess, diagnose and provide appropriate treatment,
- To contact and communicate with you,
- For administrative purposes of running the practice,
- For billing either directly or through an insurer or compensation agency,
- To discuss your medical condition within the practice if passing your case to another practitioner for your ongoing management,
- To discuss your medical condition with referral parties, doctors, teachers, coaches where permissible or appropriate (ie with your consent and/or in accordance with applicable rules and regulations) to facilitate communication and best possible care for you.



Disclosing Information

My Home Podiatrist will only disclose personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act. This means that personal information may be disclosed:

- For the purposes for which we have advised that we are collecting it, and for related purposes that the individual would reasonably expect,
- Where we have the consent of the individual to do so,
- As required by law, or
- Under other circumstances where permitted under the Act.

In the course of our business activities, we many need to disclose some of your personal information to relevant staff. We do not disclose your personal information to overseas recipients.

Unauthorised Disclosure or Access

My Home Podiatrist is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals, we will view unauthorised disclosure of, or access to, personal information by our employees or contractors, as a serious breach of this policy. Appropriate action (which may include disciplinary or legal action) will be taken in such cases.

Opt-out

We will always provide individuals with a nil-cost way of contacting us to register a request to "opt-out" or unsubscribe from receiving any newsletters, product offers, or marketing emails.

Access to Personal Information

Individuals will be able to access their personal information upon request. An administration fee may be payable for the provision of the information. However, My Home Podiatrist may occasionally need to deny access to information in accordance with the exemptions contained in The Act.

Correction of Personal Information

If you believe that any information we hold on you is inaccurate, out of date, or incomplete, please contact us in person or by email at admin@myhomepodiatrist.net.au. We rely in part upon patients advising us when their personal information changes. We will endeavour to promptly correct any information found to be inaccurate, incomplete or out of date.

Security

Our goal is to protect the personal information collected by My Home Podiatrist and its associations. Personal information will be managed confidentially and securely and destroyed appropriately when no longer required.

We will monitor and implement appropriate technical advances or management processes, to safeguard personal information.
