All riders, owners, trainers, trainees, coaches, lessees, and agents with horses entered in western dressage classes at **USEF-licensed Regular and Local shows** must be members of WDAA or pay a non-member show pass fee at the show (adults \$45; juniors \$30). Non-members can join WDAA using the **online form** before the start of the show (adults \$55; juniors \$40).

FEES:

- Tests: \$45 per test
- Rail/Eq/Pattern Classes \$20 per test
- Office Fee: \$50
- USEF Drug Fee: \$23
- AQHA Processing Fee (reports over Intro Level): \$25
- Late Fee (if able to take on late entries): \$40
- Incomplete/Inaccurate forms: \$25
- Stall Fee (Includes 4 bags of shavings): \$150
- Shavings: \$9 per bag
- Tack Stall Fee: \$120 (will be verified. If horses are found in tack rented stalls rider/owner will be required to pay immediately or forfeit entire show)
- Haul In Fee: \$50 per day
- RV Hook Up Fee: \$60 per night
- WDAA Non-Member Fee: \$55 Adults, \$40 Juniors

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS- ALL ENTRIES ARE ONLINE ONLY! (www.ringradar.com)

- 1) Fully executed entry form including ALL required signatures, ID numbers for WDAA Lifetime horse, Owner/Rider WDAA numbers, AQHA Horse and Rider numbers. Incomplete forms will not be guaranteed ride times until corrected.
- 2) Payment in full via www.ringradar.com
- 3) All signed releases for Alachua BOCC completed online or emailed in.

Refunds: Cancellations for any reason prior to the closing date will be refunded minus office fee AND Stripe Processing Fee applied by ringradar.

WEATHER DELAYS: In the case of severe weather such as rain, thunder, lightning or hail, the Show Manager on site may call for a delay of the show without consulting other committee members. When the show is resumed, it will continue in the order of go as listed in the program. IF A COMPETITOR HAS LEFT THE SHOWGROUND, IT WILL BE CONSIDERED A SCRATCH. NO REFUND OF ANY KIND WILL BE MADE. If the show cannot be resumed due to unsafe weather conditions, it will be rescheduled at a later date, not necessarily at the same venue, to be determined. STALL FEES/GROUNDS FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

Hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accident Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies (within reason- if we get ample warning for weather and chose to cancel a show we may offer to extend your entry payments to the next show or refund).

Condition of Entry - The Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel an entry, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and remove from the grounds any individual, stable, or both without claim for damages. The submitting of an entry form to the show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

No refunds after the closing date.**Rider Attire: USEF rules and guidelines will be used for attire and equipment.**

- 1) Required Attire: Suitable western hat. Protective headgear may be worn without penalty (See GR801) and is STRONGLY recommended.
- 2) Long-sleeved shirt with any type of collar: short sleeves may be worn at the judge's discretion
- 3) Trousers, pants, a one-piece long sleeved equitation suit provided it includes a collar.

- 4) Boots with distinguishable heel. •
- 5) Optional Attire: Necktie, kerchief, bolo tie or pin. A vest, jacket, coat and/or sweater. Spurs. Western style, with or without blunt tines, English dressage style, roller ball, and blunt bumper spurs are permitted. Rowels must be vertical. Spurs with sharp tines are not permitted. Chaps, shotgun chaps, chinks, armitas, or split riding skirt. Protective headgear is acceptable; not required to be of Western style.

Horse: Horses must display bridle number in hand or under saddle at all times outside of the stalls or washrack areas. This includes grazing.

Number of Tests per Horse: A horse may be ridden up to a MAXIMUM 4 times per day per show (regardless of the number of riders) excluding rail/eq classes.

Arenas:

Show arena: Introductory and basic classes will be in a small ring 20x40. All other classes will be in a 20x60.

Warm-Up Arenas: Warm up ring set to the outside from the 2 show rings. No warming up within the show rings on Saturday or Sunday! Lunge ring also provided. No lunging in the warm up areas!

Show Ribbons: First through Fifth places. High Point and Reserve High Point prizes will be given each day for Open, AA, and JR/YR, Exceptional Rider.

Ride Times: Will be posted on www.ringradar.com, and emailed WEDNESDAY before the show, at the latest.

Special Scheduling Requests:

- Some riders have special scheduling requests due to trailering arrangements, trainers that are riding and coaching, riders with two horses, etc. Although not guaranteed, every attempt will be made to honor these requests, as follows:
 - If a class can be scheduled at a time frame requested by the rider, this will be done.
 - If the class cannot be scheduled in this time frame, every attempt will be made to schedule special request rides BEFORE the balance of the class; this is necessary so other riders do not have to wait for the class to finish.
- Please note that special scheduling requests involving a wide variety of tests can be very difficult to honor, but we will try!
- Also please note that scheduling occurs after the closing date; therefore, a ride that is scratched due to a special request that cannot be honored will be considered a scratched ride and the ride fee must be paid.

Stabling:

Permanent 10x10 stalls with secured doors, Thursday 12 PM through Sunday at 7 PM. Additional nights are \$40/night. Four bags of shavings included for horse stalls.

Food: Concessions on site
