Cookie Notice

This notice explains what cookies are and the types of cookies Goneke Investment Group Proprietary Limited ("we" or "GIG") use on goneke.com, and other websites or applications that may link to this Cookie Notice (collectively, the "Sites"). We obtain certain information by automated means, such as cookies, web beacons (including pixels and tags), web server logs, and other similar technologies. This Cookie Notice explains how we use these technologies, their purposes, and how you can control them.

This Cookie Notice should be read together with our Privacy Notice, available at goneke.com. Our Privacy Notice explains how we process personal data more broadly, including your rights under the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 ("POPIA") and, where applicable, the EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and UK GDPR.

1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A "cookie" is a text file that websites send to a visitor's computer or other Internet-connected device to uniquely identify the visitor's browser or to store information or settings on the device. A "web beacon", also known as an Internet tag, pixel tag, or clear GIF, links web pages to web servers and may be used to transmit information collected through cookies back to a web server. We refer to all of these and similar technologies as "cookies" for purposes of this Cookie Notice.

2. WHY DO WE USE COOKIES ON THE SITES?

We use cookies to:

- Enhance functionality, customise, personalise, and improve users' experience;
- Deliver content tailored to users' interests and relevant online advertising;
- Perform analytics and manage our Sites and other aspects of our business; and
- Comply with applicable legal and regulatory requirements relating to security and authentication.

We will only place non-essential cookies on your device where we have obtained your prior, freely given, specific, informed, and unambiguous consent. You may withdraw your consent at any time (see Section 6 below). Essential cookies that are strictly necessary for the functioning of the Sites do not require consent.

3. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE OBTAIN THROUGH COOKIES?

The information we obtain through cookies includes your traffic data, location, logs, device IP address, identifiers associated with your devices, types of devices connected to our services, operating system, network location, browser type, web browser characteristics, device characteristics, language and country preferences, referring URLs, exit pages, clickstream data and other information on actions taken on our Sites, error information, and dates and times of website visits.

4. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

The table below sets out the categories of cookies we use. The individual cookies within each category (including their name and duration) are listed in our Cookie Preference Centre. Please note that depending on your selection, you may not be able to take full advantage of all features of the Sites.

May include identifiers associated with your account or browser to help us understand engagement with our content and communications. Advertising & Marketing Cookies	Used to deliver personalised advertising, conduct retargeting, measure campaign effectiveness, and facilitate connections to social networks (including LinkedIn, YouTube, Vimeo, Facebook, Instagram, and X). Subject to the third-party providers' own cookie policies. Where we participate in the IAB Transparency and Consent Framework (TCF v2.3), consent is managed accordingly.	Yes — opt-in consent required	Up to 24 months

We are committed to ensuring that your consent is obtained fairly and transparently. We will not use dark patterns (such as pre-selected toggles, asymmetric button designs, or consent walls) to influence your choices. You have an equal and equally prominent ability to accept or decline non-essential cookies.

8. COOKIE RETENTION

Session cookies expire when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your device for a defined period. The retention periods for specific cookies are listed in our Cookie Preference Centre. In all cases, we apply the principle of storage limitation and retain cookies no longer than is necessary for the purpose for which they were set.

We may update this Cookie Notice periodically to reflect changes in our practices, the technologies we use, or applicable law. We will update the "Last Updated" date at the top of this notice when we make changes. We recommend that you review this notice regularly.
