Cookie Notice

How Goneke Investment Group uses cookies and similar technologies on goneke.com, and how you may control them.

01 WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A “cookie” is a text file that websites send to a visitor’s computer or other internet-connected device to uniquely identify the visitor’s browser or to store information or settings on the device. A “web beacon”, also known as an internet tag, pixel tag, or clear GIF, links web pages to web servers and may be used to transmit information collected through cookies back to a web server. We refer to all of these and similar technologies as “cookies” for purposes of this notice.

This notice explains what cookies are and the types of cookies Goneke Investment Group Proprietary Limited (“we” or “GIG”) use on goneke.com, and other websites or applications that may link to this notice (collectively, the “Sites”). It should be read together with our Privacy Notice, which explains how we process personal data more broadly, including your rights under the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (“POPIA”) and, where applicable, the EU General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) and UK GDPR.

02 WHY DO WE USE COOKIES?

We use cookies to:

- Enhance functionality, customise, personalise, and improve users’ experience;
- Deliver content tailored to users’ interests and relevant online advertising;
- Perform analytics and manage our Sites and other aspects of our business; and
- Comply with applicable legal and regulatory requirements relating to security and authentication.

We will only place non-essential cookies on your device where we have obtained your prior, freely given, specific, informed, and unambiguous consent. You may withdraw your consent at any time (see §06). Essential cookies that are strictly necessary for the functioning of the Sites do not require consent.

03 WHAT INFORMATION DO WE OBTAIN?

The information we obtain through cookies includes your traffic data, location, logs, device IP address, identifiers associated with your devices, types of devices connected to our services, operating system, network location, browser type, web browser characteristics, device characteristics, language and country preferences, referring URLs, exit pages, clickstream data and other information on actions taken on our Sites, error information, and dates and times of website visits.



04 CATEGORIES OF COOKIES WE USE

The individual cookies within each category, including their name and duration, are listed in our Cookie Preference Centre. Depending on your selection, you may not be able to take full advantage of all features of the Sites.

Advertising & marketing	Delivers personalised advertising, retargeting, and campaign measurement, and facilitates connections to social networks (LinkedIn, YouTube, Vimeo, Facebook, Instagram, X). Where GIG participates in the IAB Transparency and Consent Framework (TCF v2.3), consent is managed accordingly.	Yes — opt-in	Up to 24 months

05 THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

Third parties may also set cookies on the Sites to facilitate the purposes listed above, or for their own purposes. The use of cookies by these third parties is subject to their own cookie and privacy policies, including those of Google, YouTube, Vimeo, Facebook (Meta), LinkedIn, X (formerly Twitter), and Instagram (Meta).

Where we use Google advertising services, we implement Google Consent Mode v2. When you have not consented to analytics or advertising cookies, Google will operate in a consent-restricted mode and will not use your data for personalised advertising.

06 YOUR CONSENT CHOICES

We are committed to ensuring that your consent is obtained fairly and transparently. We will not use dark patterns — pre-selected toggles, asymmetric button designs, or consent walls — to influence your choices. You have an equal and equally prominent ability to accept or decline non-essential cookies.

Browser settings

You may restrict or disable cookies through your browser settings. If you disable or remove cookies, you may not be able to take full advantage of all features on our Sites.

Global Privacy Control

We honour the Global Privacy Control (GPC) signal. If your browser or device is configured to transmit a GPC signal, we will treat this as a request to opt out of the sale or sharing of your personal information, in accordance with applicable law.

Third-party opt-out tools

You can also manage third-party cookies via the Digital Advertising Alliance (aboutads.info/choices), the Network Advertising Initiative (networkadvertising.org/choices), and EU Online Choices (youronlinechoices.eu). On mobile devices, adjust the privacy and security settings on your device.

07 CONSENT RECORDS AND AUDIT TRAIL

In accordance with POPIA and the GDPR, we maintain records of the consent you provide through our Cookie Preference Centre, including the date and time consent was given or withdrawn, the categories of cookies accepted, and the version of this notice in effect at the time. You may request a copy of your consent record by contacting us.

Where applicable law requires consent to be renewed periodically — typically every 12 months — we will prompt you to review and renew your preferences at the appropriate time.

08 COOKIE RETENTION

Session cookies expire when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your device for a defined period, listed in our Cookie Preference Centre. In all cases, we apply the principle of storage limitation and retain cookies no longer than is necessary for the purpose for which they were set.

09 UPDATES TO THIS NOTICE

We may update this notice periodically to reflect changes in our practices, the technologies we use, or applicable law. We will update the date at the top of this notice when we make changes, and recommend you review it regularly. Where changes are material, we will notify you by a prominent banner or notice on our Sites.
