Important Camp Information for Parents

1. Arrival Time: 8:45 A.M.

All children must arrive by 9:00 a.m. sharp. Any child arriving after 9:00 a.m. will be considered late and must return home for the day.

2. Weekly Payments:

All weekly payments are due on Mondays of each week. A \$25 late fee will apply to any late payments. Please Note: Closed days (3) are listed on our trip schedule

3. Trip Policy:

On trip days, if your child is not attending the trip, they must stay home. There is no in-camp care provided on trip days. Half day Trips, or split groups will not apply

4. Trip Payments:

Trip fees may be paid up to two days in advance. While payment is accepted on the morning of the trip, same-day payments do not guarantee your child a reserved spot.

5. Footwear:

All campers must wear sneakers. Open-toed shoes, sandals, Croc sandals, and flip-flops are not allowed for safety reasons.

6. Camp Uniforms:

Campers are required to wear their full camp uniform on all trips and events. Campers not in uniform will not be allowed to attend the trip or event.

7. Supplies:
