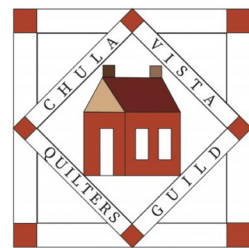

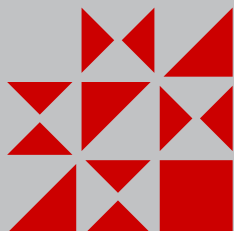

THIRTY FIVE BLOCKS - FINISHED BLOCK SIZE - 9" LAID OUT 5 X 7

BACKING OR BINDING NOT LISTED



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

TWO COLOR QUILT MODERN LOOK

BASED ON 42" WIDE FABRIC

2 YARDS LIGHT | CUT 70 6" SQUARES

2 YARDS DARK | CUT 70 6" SQUARES

SCRAP QUILT A FUN "USE IT UP" LOOK

CUT 70 MIXED LIGHT 6" SQUARES

CUT 70 MIXED DARK 6" SQUARES

(OR 2 YARDS ALL ONE LIGHT, ONE DARK)

YOU MIGHT WANT TO MAKE 2-3 EXTRA BLOCKS IN CASE THERE IS A MISS-CUT IN A LATER CLUE.

OTHER QUILT SIZES:

QUEEN SIZE - 90" X 99" YOU WILL NEED 110 BLOCKS, LAID OUT 10 X 11

CUT 220 LIGHTS AND 220 DARKS.

KING SIZE - 108" X 108" YOU WILL NEED 144 BLOCKS, LAID OUT 12 X 12

CUT 288 LIGHTS AND 288 DARKS.

BORDERS CAN BE ADDED TO ADJUST FINISHED SIZE.

TOOL SUPPLY LIST

- Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot or guide. Don't forget the cord and foot pedal.
- Sharp blade in your rotary cutter, mat, (a rotating mat is handy if you have one)
 - 12" square up or bigger.
- Scissors, pins, thread. (You might want to load about 5 bobbins beforehand)
 - Iron & small ironing board or pad to avoid a waiting line at the big ones.
 - Sharp seam ripper.
- Five 1 qt. size baggies to sort body parts in, scratch paper or post-a-notes for labels
 - Numbering system for you blocks.
- Design wall, if you have one or knee pads to lay your quilt out on the floor if you are up to it.
