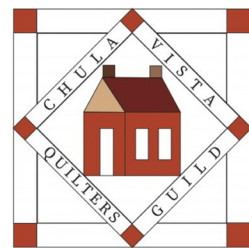

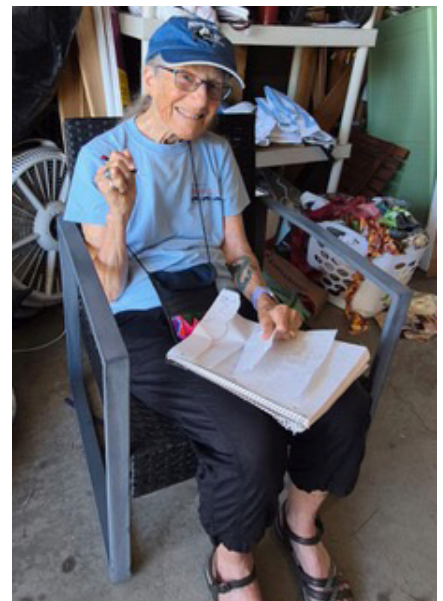
SEW IN UPDATE:

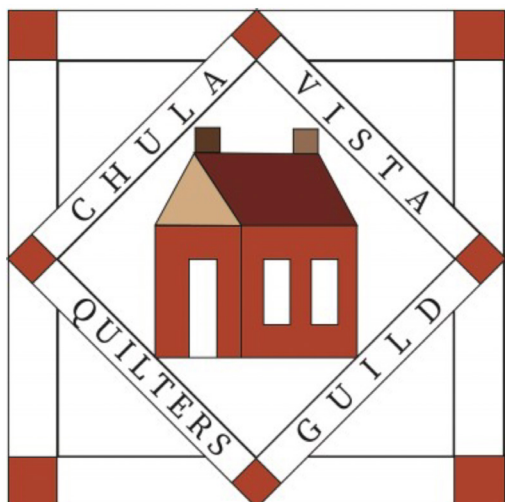

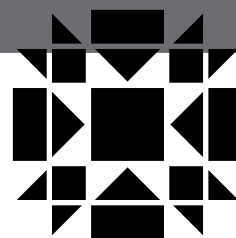
