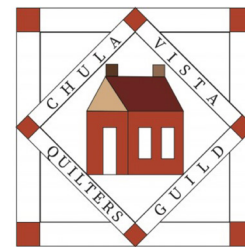

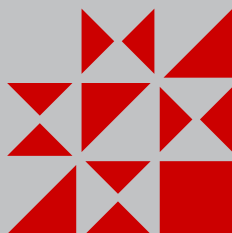

PRELIMINARY 2025 QUILT SHOW REPORT AND TENTATIVE DATES FOR 2026

We had another very successful show – congratulations to everyone who participated, volunteered and to our winners! Our church liaison was thrilled with the condition of the church after the show. She said it was like no-one had even been there, so a big “thank you” to all of you who helped strike the show. We definitely had more people helping with setup and takedown this year – it made both tasks so much faster.

Sadly, our overall attendance at the show this year was only 253 guests, down 135 people from last year. We only had 98 guests on Saturday, which is much lower than our usual Saturday attendance. I think we can blame that on the cold and rainy weather. However, all the guests that I spoke with absolutely loved the show and several said that they plan to join our guild. The vendors all said that they were happy with their sales and would like to come back next year, hurray!

Below is a table with the **rough net profits** for the guild compared to other years. Our treasurer is still gathering show expenses so a final financial report with complete expenses and income will be published later.

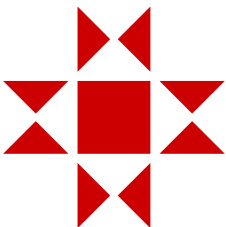

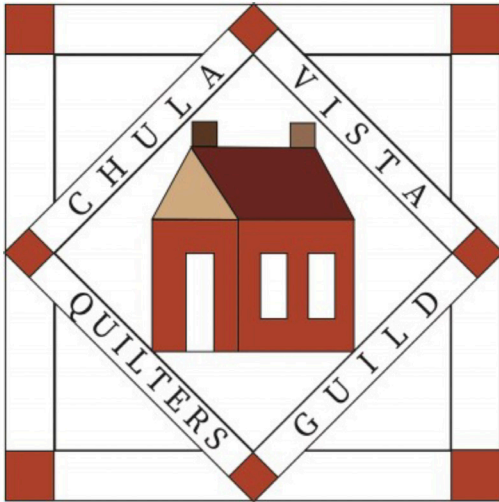

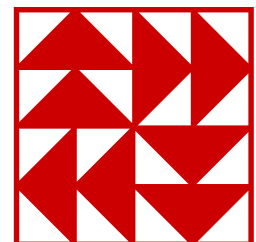
