The meeting was called to order at 5:50 P.M.

Addition to Agenda: key lock box. Mary motioned to approve the Agenda as amended and Rene seconded. AIF.

Mary motioned to approve the April minutes as presented and Debbie seconded. AIF.

VISITORS

PENDING/PAID BILLS

TEACHER REPORT

Carolyn reached out to ESD inquiring about rural subs. There are only three that will come to the schools. The ESD will let subs know that they are paid mileage each day.

The board discussed the need to get a lock box for school keys and agreed to place it in the pumphouse- Carolyn will do this and give the code to the board.

Carolyn said that a company from Ontario can come on the 30th and look at the locks in the school and give an estimate. This is paid for with SIA grant money- the company can have it done by the end of the biennium.

Joe Baker said that exit lights for tracking would be about \$1800-this is also SIA dollars.

Corbin asked if the lock box could solve the emergency health issue (there was a need for the defibulator last year and the school was locked)? Yes it will!!

Sheri and Carolyn attended Lyn Seres training and will also attend this Friday in-service.

The students are going to Diamond this week for the theatre- the performance will be Friday -potluck at 6 and play will start at 7.

The end of year party will be a breakfast this year. Flyers went out. Defensible space topic is tabled.

Carolyn said that McKinney Vento and Foster Care reports are still being worked on. The district needs to update new policy with the edit of school board instead of superintendent. The AR goes with it. Debbie motioned to approve policy JECBD/AR and Rene seconded. AIF.

Carolyn stated that she has been recommended for a national rural teacher of the year award- congratulations!

The school needs a new phone.

SAFETY COMMITTEE/PEST MANAGEMENT

New fence poles out there- Thank you Rene!! Maybe another one for gravel area by the pumphouse?

There is a gutter guard on the ground. Some of the other pieces need to get fixed.

There's one fire extinguisher that might need replaced.

NEW BUSINESS

ODE is giving a SPED stipend for employees who work with SPED students-Carolyn and Sheri will each get one. Nevada signed this agreement. Carolyn stated that she was recently notified that due to student performance, Frenchglen qualified for a Summer School Grant for approximately \$20,000 – since SIA will pay for summer learning, and she didn't have time to meet the deadline, or could spend that amount of money, she will not be applying.

Earlyna stated that there might be a possibility of a new auditor next yearan off shoot office of Oster's CPAs in John Day. They will let her know in December.

June's meeting will be held on the 10th and will include the public budget hearing.

School Fence: Rene stated that he doesn't have time. The chain link fence needs repairs as well. Carolyn will submit the fencing request to SIA for safety issues.
