



Dear Parents and Guardians,

Early registration for 2021-22 begins February 1, 2021 and will run through Friday, February 12th. If you have received this packet, you are eligible to register during the **early registration** time frame. **Open registration** for families who are not current students or not members of one of the 3 supporting churches will begin February 15th, 2021.

There are two advantages to registering early:

1. You will have until March 12th to take advantage of the registration fee of \$265 (K-8th Grade student).
2. Families who register on or before March 12th will pay lower enrollment fees. The enrollment fee increases beginning March 15th to \$335.

Member families and current families may register from Feb. 1st- March 15th and still pay the \$265 registration fee. The registration fee will go up for everyone on March 15th, 2021.

Placement is determined on a first-come, first-served basis. This is especially important if your child is in a classroom that is at or near capacity (24 for K, 25 students for 1st-8th classrooms).

Inside this packet, you will find the following forms (A brief description of each form follows):

- **Registration Form (required)**
 - One per child - Preschool through 8th grade. Complete front and back. Attach check to form. PS 3's: \$70 per child enrollment fee; PS 4's: FREE; K-8: \$265 per child enrollment fee (see time frames above).
- **Tuition Worksheet (required)**
 - **Every** family who enrolls a Kindergarten-8th grade student *and* who will pay tuition in 2020-21. Please read instructions carefully.
 - **TAC: Families who wish to apply for Tuition Assistance Credit will check the line marked TAC on the tuition worksheet. There is no separate application form for TAC. Families applying for TAC must apply for ILSTO and submit the appropriate tax paperwork to the Principal. All TAC applicants must submit a 2020 1040 Tax Page 1 with your application.**

- ****NEW FORM FOR 2021**** The Iowa Lutheran School Tuition Organization (ILSTO) offers scholarships to families who meet the income guidelines (see application). ILSTO is available for Kindergarten through 8th grade students. Due 4/23/21.

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION HELP

All parents are welcome to contact Mr. Parris to schedule an appointment to help you through the applications if you have any questions. Please do not let the paperwork overwhelm you. One other resource for financial aid is our SPICE (Special Partners in Christian Education) fund. This fund is designated for use by the Principal. We often have donors who contribute to this fund. In order to access this as a possible resource, you must have a conversation with Mr. Parris. Call the school office or email him at principal@centrallutherschool.org to set up an appointment.

Please be aware of the deadline for submitting all paperwork: April 23rd, the ILSTO paperwork needs to be postmarked by 4/23/2021 for Terril, IA.
