AS EXPLAINED IN THE MOST RECENT REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF STA (BESTA-20180518AOQ), THE STATION HAS BEEN BROADCASTING FROM THE LOCATION KNOWN AS 'ROCKY POINT' IN KERN, CA BECAUSE THE STATION'S LICENSED LOCATION, KNOWN AS 'COOK PEAK,' BECAME UNAVAILABLE IN 2016 DUE TO EXTENSIVE WILDFIRES (SEE FILE NO. BSTA-20161024ACJ).

SINCE THE TIME OF THE GRANT OF THE MOST RECENT REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF STA, THE LICENSEE OF THE STATION, ALTA SIERRA BROADCASTING, LLC ('ALTA SIERRA'), HAS BEEN WORKING WITH THE ADMINISTRATORS OF ROCKY POINT REGARDING A SOLUTION TO ALLOW THE STATION TO OPERATE FROM ROCKY POINT ON A PERMANENT BASIS. IF THE STATION ULTIMATELY OBTAINS AUTHORITY TO OPERATE FROM ROCKY POINT, IT LIKELY WILL BECOME NECESSARY FOR ALTA SIERRA TO SEEK AUTHORITY TO ERECT A NEW TOWER, A PROCESS THAT, AS THE COMMISSION IS AWARE, CAN TAKE MANY MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

WHILE DISCUSSIONS ARE ONGOING REGARDING THE LOCATION FOR THE STATION'S PERMANENT OPERATIONS, ALTA SIERRA RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS AN EXTENSION OF STA IN ORDER TO CONTINUE OPERATING THE STATION FROM THE ROCKY POINT SITE. ALTA SIERRA WILL INFORM THE COMMISSION OF FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS.

THE CURRENT LICENSEE, ALTA SIERRA BROADCASTING, LLC, ACQUIRED THE STATION ON JUNE 30, 2017. SINCE THAT TIME, THE STATION HAS BEEN CONTINUING TO BROADCAST FROM THE LOCATION KNOWN AS 'ROCKY POINT' IN KERN, CA BECAUSE THE STATION'S PRIOR LICENSED LOCATION WAS DESTROYED IN 2016 (SEE FILE NO. BSTA-20161024ACK).

ALTA SIERRA HAS BEEN NEGOTIATING WITH THE OWNERS/ADMINISTRATORS OF THE ROCKY POINT SITE, IN ANTICIPATION THAT KRVQ-FM MAY BE LOCATED THERE ON A PERMANENT BASIS. HOWEVER, THOSE NEGOTIATIONS HAVE NOT BEEN FINALIZED, IN PART BECAUSE THE U.S. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, WHICH OPERATES THE SITE, HAS BEEN FOCUSED ON OTHER MATTERS, INCLUDING DEALING WITH THE HORRIFIC WILDFIRES THAT HAVE PLAGUED MANY AREAS IN CALIFORNIA OVER THE PRECEDING MONTHS.

ALTA SIERRA WILL ADVISE THE COMMISSION ONCE THE LONG-TERM PLANS FOR KCNQ HAVE BEEN FINALIZED.

IN THE MEANTIME, GRANT OF THIS REQUEST IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST, AS IT WILL ALLOW LISTENERS IN THE LAKE ISABELLA AND SURROUNDING AREAS TO CONTINUE RECEIVING IMPORTANT NEWS AND WEATHER ALERTS THAT THE STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDING, ALONG WITH THE STATION'S REGULAR PROGRAMMING.

DUE TO EXTENSIVE WILDFIRES IN THE LAKE ISABELLA AREA OF KERN RIVER, WHERE THE KCNQ TRANSMITTER SITE IS LOCATED (SEE, E.G., KTLA.COM/2016/06/25/ERSKINE-FIRE-1500-STRUCTURES-THREATENED-BY-46-SQUARE-MILE-WILDFIRE-IN-KERN-COUNTY-CONTAINMENT-AT-5/), THE KCNQ (FM) TRANSMITTER SITE HAS BEEN ESSENTIALLY DESTROYED. BY THIS REQUEST, KCNQ SEEKS CONSENT TO OPERATE FROM THE COORDINATES SET FORTH HEREIN, KNOWN AS 'ROCKY POINT' IN KERN, CA.

THE SITE IS OWNED BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, AND THE STATION HAS RECEIVED AUTHORIZATION TO OPERATE KCNQ FROM THAT LOCATION. AT THIS TIME, THE STATION CANNOT PROVIDE AN EDUCATED ESTIMATE AS TO HOW LONG OPERATIONS FROM THIS SITE WILL CONTINUE, AS THE STATION IS IN THE PROCESS OF EVALUATING NEXT STEPS TOWARDS RE-BUILDING THE STATION. THIS PROCESS COULD TAKE SIX MONTHS OR MORE.

THE STATION WILL ADVISE THE COMMISSION WHEN LICENSED OPERATIONS EITHER HAVE BEEN

RESTORED, OR ALTERNATE PLANS ARE FINALIZED.

IN THE MEANTIME, GRANT OF THIS REQUEST IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST, AS IT WILL ALLOW LISTENERS IN THE LAKE ISABELLA AND SURROUNDING AREAS TO RECEIVE IMPORTANT NEWS AND WEATHER ALERTS THAT THE STATION IS PROVIDING, ALONG WITH THE STATION'S REGULAR PROGRAMMING.
