Dr. Scott Deppe, Conductor

Scott Deppe retired from Lamar University in Beaumont, where he served as Director of Bands. This position included directing the Wind Ensemble, Instrumental Methods and Conducting, Graduate Instrumental Music courses, and overseeing the entire instrumental program. In 2010, he was responsible for preparing the addition of a Marching Band to the curriculum. In 2015, the Lamar University Wind Ensemble performed at the TMEA convention.

Prior to Lamar, Deppe taught at Klein High School. Under his direction, the Klein Wind Ensemble was named one of five National Winners in Class 5A by the National Wind Band Honors Competition. As Associate Conductor of the Klein High School Full Orchestra, the orchestra was chosen as the 2007 TMEA State Honor Orchestra and performed at the 2008 TMEA convention. He previously taught at Nacogdoches HS, Spring Hill JH, Jasper MS, McCullough JH, and Bridge City HS. The McCullough band was a state honor band finalist twice, and the Bridge City band was a state honor band finalist once. The Spring Hill JH band performed at the TMEA convention in 1993 as the Class C State Honor Band. That same year, he was named as the Phi Beta Mu Young Bandmaster of Texas.

Dr. Deppe graduated from Stephen F. Austin in 1985 with a Bachelor of Fine Arts. He earned a Master of Music Education Degree from Lamar University in 1990. He received his Doctorate in Educational Leadership in 2012. In 2015, he received his Certification in Philanthropy from the Boston University Center for Professional Education. He is also a 2012 graduate of Leadership Beaumont. His research includes music advocacy, student leadership development, and the relationships between music and math. Dr. Deppe currently works in sales for Swicegood Music Company in Beaumont, is a University Supervisor for Lamar University student teachers, and enjoys serving as a mentor for many directors.

Sheily Bell, Conductor

Sheily Bell is the Director of Bands at Dutchtown High School. She has been teaching for nearly 50 years. She has a B.M.E. and Master + 30 from Louisiana State University. Over 85% of her college bound seniors receive band scholarships, many of which receive full tuition. Ms. Bell was selected Bandmaster of the Year for LBA, Phi Beta Mu Bandmaster of the Year and Outstanding Band Director of the year from SCRMC. Her Symphonic Winds performed at the Ark-La Tex Conference, Loyola Invitational Band Festival, the SCRMC Conference, and a Festival at Carnegie Hall and have consistently received Superior ratings at the District, State and National levels. Her marching band has performed at the Boskov Thanksgiving Parade in Philadelphia and received Superior ratings at the District and State levels. Her bands were Grand Champions in festivals held in Florida, Texas, Tennessee, and runner up in Tennessee and Chicago.

She is a past recipient of the John Philip Sousa Foundation's Legion of Honor Award. Ms. Bell is constantly in demand to adjudicate band festivals, direct Honor Bands, and give clinics throughout the State of Louisiana as well as parts of Mississippi, Arkansas, Tennessee, and Texas

Ms. Bell is a member of NAFME, L.M.E.A, NBA, District IV Honor Band Association, Phi Beta Mu, Association of Concert Bands, LAE and state chair for ASBDA. Ms. Bell taught Music Appreciation at River Parish Community College in Sorrento for 10 years. She is a member of the Civic Orchestra Baton Rouge. She is serving as the Conductor of the Baton Rouge Community Band for 20 years or more. They were chosen to perform at the National Association of Concert Bands Convention in Houston, Gainesville, and Pensacola. Ms. Bell was the National award winner of the ACB's Mentor Ideal Award (teacher of teachers).

Ms. Bell was married to the late Patrick Bell Sr. They were married 47 years and have two sons Patrick Jr. and Brady. The eldest of their 5 grandchildren played trumpet in Mrs. Bell's high school band and is a member of the LSU Tiger Band.

Dr. Jeffery C. Mathews, Conductor

After receiving his bachelor's degree from Northwestern State University in 1990, Dr. Mathews taught high school band for seven years in Louisiana and Texas. Dr. Mathews' received the Master of Music Education degree from the University of North Texas, where he served as a Teaching Fellow. He continued his studies with Thomas Frascillo at the University of Southern Mississippi where he earned the Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in conducting pedagogy.

Dr. Mathews was on the faculty of Northwestern State University from 1998 to 2021, as the Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music, instructing in Band, Marching Band Techniques, Music Theory, Conducting, and Music Education. His research has been published by the Journal of Band Research and he has presented clinics at the Louisiana Music Educators Association Convention and the Texas Music Educators Association Convention. His ensembles at NSU have been selected to perform at the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles International Conference in Spain and at the Southern Division Conference of the College Band Directors National Association.

Dr. Mathews is also a regular guest conductor with the Royal Northern College of Music Wind Orchestra in the United Kingdom. Dr. Mathews served for 15 years as the Commander and Conductor of the Texas Air National Guard Band. He led this band on a tour of the Czech Republic during the summer of 1999 and to Afghanistan and Iraq in 2007. In 2011, he was appointed Chief, Air National Guard Bands. In this capacity, he advises, directs policy, and provides budgets for all the Air National Guard Bands in the United States.

Dr. Mathews is currently a band director at Lowell H. Strike Middle School in The Colony, Texas.
