Aaron Theall is currently the Director of Bands at DeRidder High School. Aaron is in his 11th year of teaching, all of which he has taught both the DeRidder High School and DeRidder Junior High School bands. In his free time, Aaron enjoys playing in various musical ensembles on various instruments; Aaron plays french horn in the Lake Charles Community Band, tenor horn in the Calcasieu British Brass Band, baritone saxophone in the Southwest Jazz Ensemble, and rings hand bells and plays french horn in the orchestra at First Baptist Church in DeRidder, Louisiana.

Aaron is a 2012 graduate of Louisiana State University where he received a bachelor of music education in instrumental music. In 2012, while attending LSU, he was named a Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges. In 2022, he was named a Top Professional in the Marquis Who's Who Publication as a Top Educator. He was also recognized in 2013 as a recipient for the Louisiana Music Educators Association's Outstanding Young Music Teacher Award. He is the recipient of the 2022-2023 District V Band and Orchestra Directors Association's Dr. Norman E Smith Band Director of the Year Award.

Aaron has served as an honor band clinician, both concert and marching band judge, and LMEA conference presenter. He served as the Vice President for the District V Band and Orchestra Directors Association from 2014-2019. In 2014, he joined the instructional staff of the Louisiana Stars Drum and Bugle Corps where he became the Assistant Corps Director for 2015-2018. He served as the Corps director from 2019-2021 and as the executive director for 2022. He is a member of District V Band and Orchestra Directors Association, Louisiana Music Educators Association, Louisiana Bandmasters Association, Louisiana Music Adjudicators Association, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity, Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, and Phi Beta Mu.

This Award is given in memory of Dr. Norman E. Smith. Dr. Smith was Professor Emeritus of Music at McNeese State University. Not only a teacher, but also a friend to all educators and musicians. A great deal of Dr. Smith's teaching career was spent as a band director. Congratulations, Mr. Theall.

Cory Joy Craig, Conductor

Louisiana music educator and professional saxophonist, was born into an abusive and at-risk environment in Brea, California. At ten years old, she and her siblings were placed into the foster care system. Craig attended La Paz Intermediate School in her second foster home where she was “accidentally” placed into the Intermediate Band class with no prior band experience. As a result of this incredible instruction under Daniel Robbins, she dedicated her life to the cause of music and music education in hopes of providing the same experience to the impoverished and abused. She pursued summer internships in intercity churches that worked with educating students in impoverished communities. While doing so, she continued her pursuits of music education in college, eventually graduating from Louisiana Tech University in Ruston, LA where she received her Bachelor’s Degree in Instrumental Music Education K-12. Craig began her teaching journey as a music director at Herndon Magnet School where she fully managed band, jazz band, guitar, piano, and show choir programs and was named both Middle School Teacher and Middle School Band Director of the Year. While teaching at Herndon, she accepted the role as Community Partnership Music Teacher Leader in Caddo Parish Schools where she communicated, connected, and organized opportunities for Caddo music programs to perform in the community. Craig then directed middle school band, percussion, and jazz band at a Title I school called Ruston Junior High School where she received the Outstanding Young Music Educator Award from the Louisiana Music Educators Association. She is currently the Alumni of the Year in the College of Music at Louisiana Tech, an active member of the Bossier Chamber of Commerce, band leader of her own professional jazz band called Everett Street Jazz, and teaches 5th Grade Recorder and 6th grade Beginning Band at Benton Intermediate School with 600+ students in her program where she is beginning their new chapter in Tri-M Honors Society. She received the prestigious Golden Star Award in March 2021 from the Bossier Parish School Board for her service to her students inside and outside of the classroom. She is a GRAMMY Music Educator Award Nominee Finalist for the 2022 GRAMMY Academy Awards and Semi-Finalist for 2023. Today she continues to reach and inspire her students, foster youth, their families, fellow music educators, and the community at large through quality music education and community service.

Jessica Fain graduated in 2009 from Northwestern State University with a Bachelor of Music Education Degree. She is currently in her fourteenth-year teaching and is in her third year as the band director at Bluff Middle School in Ascension Parish. Prior to teaching at Bluff Middle School, Ms. Fain was the band director at Tioga Junior High where she followed many successful band directors and maintained the long-standing success of the program.

Throughout her career, Ms. Fain's bands have consistently received superior and excellent ratings at both the District and State levels. Her students have been invited to perform at the Louisiana Concert Band Invitational in Lafayette, Louisiana as well.

Ms. Fain also served as the Assistant Band Director at Tioga High School where she helped lead the band to many Superior Ratings during marching season. Her primary responsibilities included instructing the percussion section which consistently received high ratings including Best in Class and Most Outstanding Percussion at a number of competitions.

In addition to her responsibilities at Bluff Middle School, Ms. Fain also serves as the District Director for LMEA District IV, President of Louisiana Bandmasters Association, State Chair for the National Band Association, and President-Elect of the Louisiana Music Adjudicators Association. She has also served as an honor band clinician and as an adjudicator across Louisiana and Texas.

Ms. Fain was selected by her colleagues as the District II Band Director of the Year (2011), Tioga Junior High Teacher of the Year (2013 & 2016), received the Golden Apple Teacher Award (2015 & 2016) and was named as the Bandmaster of the Year for Louisiana Bandmasters Association (2018). She has presented at LMEA and was published in the November issue of The Instrumentalist (2018). She is a member of NAFME, NBA, LMEA, TMEA, Louisiana Bandmasters Association, LMAA, and Phi Beta Mu.

Ms. Fain resides in Baton Rouge with her fiancé, Chris Blanchard, & their wonderful dog Blue.

Under Mr. Ochoa's direction the LCM Band consistently earned superior ratings at UIL Marching Contest, UIL Concert and Sight-Reading Contest, and other contests throughout the state. In 2018, the LCM Marching Band was a finalist at the UIL State Marching Contest and in 2019 the LCM Wind Ensemble placed 3rd in the TMEA State Honor Band Contest. Dr. Kelvin Jones, Conductor

Dr. Kelvin Jones is the Assistant Director of Bands at Louisiana State University. His responsibilities include conducting the LSU Symphonic Band, teaching undergraduate conducting, Marching Band techniques, working with graduate students, and leading the Sudler-winning, 325-member "Golden Band from Tigerland." Bands under Jones' direction have performed at events on the state and national level, including the Zulu Mardi Gras parade, New Orleans Saints, in Washington DC, Walt Disney World, the Southeastern Conference (SEC) Championship in Atlanta, GA, College Football Playoff (CFP) Peach Bowl and the CFP National Championship games. Under his direction, numerous performances of the LSU Tiger Marching Band have been selected for recognition and viewing at regional and national conferences of the College Band Directors National Association, including the Athletic Band Symposium.

Dr. Jones is an active drill designer and music arranger for high school and university music programs across the country with his arrangements being performed throughout the United States, including the Dallas Winds. As a conductor, Jones has conducted ensembles international and nationally, including the Cannon Center for the Performing Arts in Memphis, TN and Carnegie Hall in New York City. He has worked on new music commissioning projects and has received praise on his interpretations from composers Steven Bryant, Alex Shapiro, Omar Thomas, John Mackey, Anthony Barfield, Ayatey Shabazz, Joshua Hobbs, among others.

In great demand as a guest conductor, Jones is an active clinician, and has travelled internationally working with music programs in South America (Chile) and with the LSU marching band in Dublin, Ireland. He also serves as a clinician/instructor at the Smith-Walbridge Drum Major Clinic held in Charleston, Illinois working with high school and college drum majors from across the country. Jones has also served as a consultant for school districts and music programs throughout the country along with presenting at international, national, and state music conferences across the United States. He is published in the Instrumentalist magazine, Teaching Music Through Performance in Band series, distributed by GIA Publications, the Oxford University Press Publications, among others.

Jones is a former recipient of the Louisiana Music Educators Association's Young Music Educator of the Year, Baton Rouge Symphony Orchestra's Teacher of Distinction, and the LSU A.P. Tureaud award recipient for significant contributions to the university. He has received numerous accolades and distinctions for his contributions within the local community from community leaders including the governor and Baton Rouge mayor. A huge advocate and champion for diversity, inclusion, and equal rights, Jones serves as an ambassador for the university through his service and mentorship across various initiatives and contributions throughout campus, recently he received the 2022 LSU Faculty Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Mentorship award given to faculty who are making outstanding contributions to the mentoring activities of faculty, staff and/or students from underrepresented groups

A former K-12 public school educator, he was the band director at West Feliciana High School in St. Francisville, Louisiana. At WFHS, he led an active, comprehensive music program that produced numerous award-winning performances at state and national events, including the 2013 United States National Presidential Inauguration Music Festival in Washington DC. He holds degrees in Music from Jackson State University and Louisiana State University. He is a member of the College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Education, Kappa Kappa Psi Fraternity Inc., LSU Black Faculty and Student Caucus, Louisiana Music Educators Association, HBCU Band Directors Consortium, and Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc.
