Eric LeBlanc is a native of Abbeville, LA, and a graduate of Abbeville High School. While in high school, he studied saxophone with the late Santy Runyon of Runyon Products and began playing saxophone in various church, school, and civic organizations. He went on to graduate from the University of Louisiana – Lafayette, receiving many scholarships including the Romaine Picard Memorial Scholarship and the Outstanding Senior Bandsmen Scholarship. He was a member of Phi Kappa Phi Honors Society, the College Honors Program, and served as a representative to the Dean of the School of Music's Advisory Board for Two Years.

After graduating, he then went on to teach band and culinary arts at Pickering Jr. / Sr. High School in Fort Polk, LA. Eric has taught middle school band in Lafayette Parish teaching at Paul Breaux Middle School and Edgar Martin Middle School. He now teaches at Paul Breaux Middle School and serves as the director of the Concert, Intermediate, Cadet, Jazz, Percussion Ensemble, and Pep Bands (Tiger Band). He serves as department head at Paul Breaux Middle for electives and physical education courses. Eric has been nominated numerous times for the LEF (Lafayette Education Foundation) Teacher of the year Award, and was one of the finalists for the LEF Teacher of The Year Award for middle school teacher of the year in 2010. In 2019 he was selected by his colleagues to be the Paul Breaux Middle teacher of the year, and was a semifinalist for the middle school teacher of the year in Lafayette Parish in that same year. He is a proud member of Phi Beta Mu and LMAA.

His bands consistently perform to superior ratings at both the local and state levels. The Paul Breaux Bands also perform for numerous civic and community events throughout the Greater Lafayette area. He also helps prepare young teachers as a mentor teacher, and serves as vice-president for the area band directors' association (SLBDA). He is also one of the middle school chair-persons for SLBDA's middle school honor band, and LeBlanc is the first recipient from Lafayette Parish to win the Louisiana Music Educators' Association Standard of Excellence Award. Eric is a member of Phi Mu Alpha's Friends of Music Society. His band program was recently recognized as the "Spirit of Acadiana" on KATC's evening newscast in 2022 for their work performing a concert series at local hospitals and helping to raise funds for area charities. Eric is active as a clinician and as a musician playing saxophone in the Acadiana area. He lives with his amazing wife Sarah and their beautiful daughters Isabella and Maria in Leroy, LA.

Katie Codina-Eagleson is in her seventeenth year of teaching. She spent nine years as the Director of the Central Mustang Bands in Gonzales, LA and seven years as the Director of Middle School Bands and High School Marching Band at Holy Cross School. Recently Mrs. Codina moved back to her hometown of Lafayette where she is now serving as the Director of Bands at Edgar Martin Middle School and Broadmoor Elementary.

Mrs. Codina is a summa cum laude graduate of Loyola University-New Orleans with a Bachelor of Music Education. She has performed as Principal Flutist with the Loyola Wind Ensemble and Symphony Orchestra, Piccoloist with the Acadian Wind Symphony, and Principal Flute in the CBDNA Intercollegiate Honor Band. Other ensembles she has performed with include the Lafayette Concert Band, Crescent City Wind Symphony, and the New Orleans Concert Band.

Mrs. Codina has received the Theodore Presser Musician of the Year Award, the Rev. R.J. McNaspy Musician of the Year Award, and the Sigma Alpha Iota International Music Fraternity for Women Sword of Honor. In 2011 Ms. Codina was named "Elementary Band Director of the Year" by the District VI Band Director's Association. She has conducted District and Parish Honor Bands and adjudicated for District and Parish Band Festivals throughout Louisiana.

Ms. Codina is a member of the Louisiana Music Educators Association for which she was a board member and District IV Director for several years. She is also a member of the National Association for Music Education and Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. In 2020, Ms. Codina was a part of a committee of Louisiana directors who founded and established the Louisiana Music Adjudicators Association of which she served as the first President.

Under her direction, the Central and Holy Cross Bands have consistently been awarded superior sweepstakes ratings at district concert and marching festivals.

Robert is Director of Bands at West Monroe High School, a position he has held since 2003. Previously, he was Associate Director from 1997-2003.

Robert is a native of West Monroe, LA and a graduate of West Monroe High School. He received the Bachelor of Music Education from Northwestern State University in Natchitoches, LA and the Master of Music in Euphonium Performance from the University of Southern Mississippi. He has held positions as Brass Professor at Pearl River Community College in Poplarville, MS and Director of Bands at North Forrest High School in Hattiesburg, MS. Robert is active as a clinician and adjudicator with wind bands as well as the marching arts and is a Charter Member of the Louisiana Music Adjudicators Association.

Robert's bands have consistently garnered superior ratings in marching, concert and sight-reading. His bands have placed highly in regional, state and national performance competitions. They have appeared in many high profile events, including the 2005 Inaugural Parade of George W. Bush and the Inauguration of LA Governor Bobby Jindal. They made their first international appearance at the 2014 London New Years Day Parade in Westminster, UK. Most recently, the West Monroe High School Band was chosen as the Louisiana representative in the 58th Presidential Inaugural Parade. His professional affiliations include Phi Beta Mu, ASBDA, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, LMEA, LMAA and the District I Band Directors Association. He has been received recognition by SBO Magazine in 50 Teachers Who Make a Difference and has been awarded the National Band Association Citation of Excellence. He most recently received the John Philip Sousa Foundation Legion of Honor Award at the Midwest Clinic in 2019.

Dr. Jay Jacobs, Conductor

Jay Jacobs is Associate Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at the University of South Carolina, where he is the director of The Carolina Band, conducts the Symphonic Winds and teaches courses within the School of Music. He holds the Bachelor of Music in Music Education degree from West Virginia University, where he studied trumpet with John Winkler and conducting with Don Wilcox. Dr. Jacobs earned the Master of Music in Conducting and Doctor of Philosophy in Music Education degrees from the University of Florida, studying in the conducting studio of David Waybright.

Within Drum Corps International, Dr. Jacobs performed as a member of the Bluecoats Drum and Bugle Corps from Canton, Ohio and with The Cavaliers Drum and Bugle Corps from Rosemont, Illinois. He was a five-year member of The Cavaliers brass staff, working with Gordon Henderson, Timothy Salzman and Bill Watson.

Dr. Jacobs' career in public education included teaching as a middle school and high school band director in Kirkland, Illinois, and prior to his appointment at USC, he served as Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at McNeese State University in Lake Charles, Louisiana. Under his direction, the ensembles gained recognition on the state, national and international level.

Dr. Jacobs has served as a presenter, clinician and adjudicator in West Virginia, Illinois, Georgia, Florida, South Carolina, Iowa, Louisiana, Pennsylvania, Texas, and the United Kingdom. He has performed in and conducted ensembles internationally and served as a guest conductor with the Lake Charles Symphony Orchestra. He is a recipient of the McNeese President's Award for Outstanding Mentorship and was selected as the 2015 Faculty Member of the Year by the McNeese Student Government Association. Dr. Jacobs is an honorary member the Alpha Eta. Iota Upsilon and Zeta Chi chapters of Kappa Kappa Psi and the Beta Xi chapter of Tau Beta Sigma, the national band service fraternity and sorority. He is an honorary member of the Rho Zeta chapter of Phi Mu Alpha, as well as a member of the National Band Association, National Association for Music Education, and the national bandmasters fraternity, Phi Beta Mu. He has also served as the Louisiana State Chair for CBDNA and the University/Research Division Chair for the Louisiana Music Educators Association.
