SAGE SHOOTING RANGE RULES

!!!!! FIRST THINK SAFETY !!!!!

- 1. NO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WHILE SHOOTING
- 2. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times when shooting.
- 3. Always make sure it is safe before going down range.
- 4. Targets:
 - a. When shooting steel targets, the minimum distance is 10 yds for pistols calibers and 100 yds for rifle calibers
 - b. No rifle calibers are to be shot at steel targets on the upper/short ranges.
 - c. No steel core or steel jacked bullets are to be shot at the steel targets
 - d. Do not shoot shotguns at the target boards
 - e. No glass on any range as targets
- 5. Make sure the appropriate range flag is raised before shooting. If you are the only shooter on the range, take it down when you are done.
 - a. Upper Ranges: Located at the shade area in the middle of the facility
 - b. Lower Rifle and Shotgun area: Located adjacent to the rifle area
- 6. When using the 500 yd targets
 - a. Make sure no one is on the other ranges
 - b. Put the sign out
 - c. Block the road with the safety cones so no one can proceed onto the range.
 - d. If someone comes onto the range immediately cease fire
- 7. Keep the range clean
 - a. Don't leave a mess for others
 - b. Return any equipment used or moved
 - c. Take your trash and targets with you or put it in the trash cans
 - d. Brass cases can be left on the ground but pick up your shotgun cases
- 8. Shut and lock the gate when entering and exiting the range
