For seven-nights, parents will get to work remotely in next-gen co-working spaces, alongside other tech, creative and entrepreneurial professionals, while the kids broaden their hearts,

minds and horizons through phenomenal educational experiences for all ages such as: Learning to surf on a black sand beach with warm waves, stunning vistas, and expert instructors; Paddle boarding amidst sea turtles and eagle rays in the crystalline waters of the lagoon; Rowing traditional Polynesian outrigger canoes while spotting dolphins and colorful fish. Onsite daycare is also provided upon request for children ages 3+.

WWB's Co-Working Adventure at Intercontinental Tahiti Resort & Spa is available from \$3,626 per family and includes:

COVID-19 Entry Requirements

With the May 1 reopening, no quarantine requirements are in effect for travelers who are vaccinated against Covid-19 or show proof of recent recovery. However, all travelers (age 11 and up) still have to provide proof of a negative Covid test taken within three days of departing for Tahiti and take another test upon arrival. Travelers without proof of a vaccine or antibodies will have to quarantine for 10 days on arrival. Children under the age of six are exempt from the travel requirements. For the return test required for travelers to get back into the United States, there is a rapid testing facility inside the airport.
