

THE POWER OF EXPERIENCE

(Acts 10:44-47)

Experience (noun): practical contact with and observation of facts or events.

Experience (verb): encounter or undergo an event or occurrence.

God's word is designed to produce results (1 Thess. 2:13).

Biblical doctrine is confirmed by experience (Mark 16:20).

Experience separates truth from error (Gal. 3:2).

Experience verifies correct interpretation (Rom. 4:5-12).

You are the world's leading authority on your experience (John 9:24-25).

Not all experiences are of God (Isaiah 8:19-20).

A doctrine that doesn't play out in experience is usually unimportant.

We are to seek biblical experiences (1 Cor. 12:31, 14:1).
